



6th Indian Revenue Open Shooting Championship – 2026

Air Rifle & Air Pistol Events

The Indian Revenue Officers Shooting Club (IROSC), New Delhi, is pleased to announce the “6th Indian Revenue Open Shooting Championship – 2026”, in Air Rifle and Air Pistol events.

Venue: Government Co-educational Senior Secondary School, Kalkaji No. 3, New Delhi.

Dates: 01 August 2026 to 04 August 2026.

All interested shooters are requested to carefully read the following terms and conditions before submitting their entries.

1. Eligibility for Participation

1.1 The Championship is open to individual shooters as well as shooters representing State Rifle Associations, District Rifle Associations, Units, Shooting Ranges, Schools, Colleges, Clubs, and Institutions.

1.2 The minimum age for participation in Air Rifle and Air Pistol events is 10 years.

2. Competition Details

2.1 The matches will be conducted in “NR” and “ISSF” categories. However, all matches shall be of 40 shots each.

2.2 All matches will be conducted on electronic targets.

2.3 Air Rifle and Air Pistol events will be conducted simultaneously.

2.4 Any athlete who has participated in “ISSF” category in any shooting event previously shall not be eligible to participate under the “NR” category.

2.5 IROSC reserves the right to modify any rule, if required, for the smooth conduct of the competition.

2.6 For the purpose of this Championship, the term “ISSF Shooter” shall mean any athlete who has participated in NRAI-recognized ISSF category competitions during the current or preceding competition year, or who otherwise falls within the ISSF category as per NRAI regulations prevailing at the time of the Championship. Shooters who have participated in Pre-State Championship/State Championship/AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship/India Open Competition or in NSCC and failed to achieve MQS are eligible to participate in NR Matches.

2.7 The first relay in all events shall commence at 0930 hrs on all competition days.

2.8 IROSC reserves the right to limit the number of entries depending upon available shooting lanes and the duration of the tournament.

3. Competition Categories

3.1 Open Category Air Rifle and Air Pistol “ISSF” and “NR”

The age of a shooter in this category shall be determined as on 31st December 2026.

- Sub Youth: Below 16 years
- Youth: Below 19 years
- Junior: Below 21 years
- Senior: 21 years and above
- Masters: Above 45 years
- Senior Masters: Above 60 years

3.2 Departmental Category (Serving and Retired)

- Men and Women in Rifle and Pistol, “ISSF” and “NR”.

3.3 Para Category (SH1 only)

- Men and Women combined in Rifle and Pistol (Standing/Sitting)
- No entry will be accepted under Para Category without a medical categorization certificate.

4. Multiple Category Participation

4.1 A Sub Youth shooter may participate in Youth, Junior, and Senior categories upon payment of the applicable additional entry fee.

4.2 A Youth shooter may participate in Junior and Senior categories upon payment of the applicable additional entry fee.

4.3 A Junior shooter may participate in the Senior category upon payment of the applicable additional entry fee.

4.4 Participation in multiple eligible categories shall not create any right to change relay, time, date or sequence of firing unless permitted by the Managing Committee due to exceptional circumstances.

5. Registration and Entry Procedure

5.1 Online Registration

5.1.1 All Participants must first complete Shooter Registration on the portal “irosc.in”.

5.1.2 **IMPORTANT - Shooters other than personnel of Customs, CGST, Income Tax etc. falling under the Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India, should NOT select the option “Department Member”.**

5.1.3 Upon verification and approval of the submitted details, an email confirmation will be sent, after which the shooter may submit the tournament entry online through the portal.

5.1.4 In case of any discrepancy in the submitted information or documents, the applicant will be informed via email and may resubmit the required information/documents to IROSC at “iroscdelhi@gmail.com” for re-validation and approval of registration.

5.2 Registration for “Para” Category

5.2.1 Participants in the “Para” category are exempted from online registration.

5.2.2 They must send the following details along with supporting documents to:

5.2.3 Acceptable proof of age and identity shall include Passport, Aadhaar Card, Birth Certificate, School Certificate or any Government-issued document showing date of birth.

5.2.4 The Organising Committee may seek clarification or additional documentation wherever the identity, category, departmental eligibility or age of a participant requires verification.

6. Entry Fee

6.1 Entry fee is ₹1,500/- (Rupees Fifteen Hundred only) per match.

6.2 Payment must be made online through the IROSC portal.

6.3 Participants in the “Para” category shall pay the entry fee in cash at the venue before commencement of the match.

7. Last Date for Entries

- With Normal Entry Fee: Up to 24 July 2026
- With Late Entry (Triple Fee): Up to 26 July 2026

No entries shall be accepted thereafter.

On the spot entries will be accepted during the course of the tournament with triple fee only if lanes are available.

7.1 Acceptance of late or on-the-spot entries shall be subject to range capacity, relay availability, administrative feasibility and the decision of IROSC.

8. Competitor Card

8.1 All participants (except those in the “Para” category) must carry a printed copy of their Competitor Card downloaded from the IROSC portal.

8.2 Shooters without a valid Competitor Card will not be permitted to participate.

9. Documents Required for Verification

Participants must carry the following original documents:

- Proof of Name and Age
- Membership Proof of State/Unit/Club or NRAI (If any)

- Medical categorization certificate (for “Para” category participants – SH1 only)
- Government ID card for Departmental athletes
- Retired Departmental personnel claiming participation in Departmental events shall carry proof of retirement/service identity documentation.

9.1 Failure to produce required original documents at the time of verification may result in denial of participation, change of category, or disqualification, as the case may be.

10. Allocation of Shooting Details

10.1 Shooting details and relays will be allotted automatically.

10.2 No requests for change of date, relay, or timing shall be entertained except under exceptional circumstances and subject to the sole discretion of the Managing Committee.

10.3 Shooters shall report at the designated reporting area at least 30 minutes before their allotted relay time. Failure to report in time may result in denial of participation in that relay, and no claim for refund or re-allotment shall be entertained as a matter of right.

10.4 Shooters shall remain personally responsible for checking their relay, firing point, event category and reporting time from the official communication or portal.

11. Equipment and Range Facilities

11.1 Compressed air shall be available at the range against cash payment.

11.2 Shooters must make their own arrangements for arms, ammunition, and other shooting accessories.

11.3 Shooting clothing and equipment must strictly conform to ISSF Rules.

11.4 Shooters not complying with prescribed equipment standards shall not be permitted to participate.

11.5 The Organising Committee may conduct mandatory or random equipment inspections before, during or after the competition. Non-compliant equipment may result in warning, correction requirement, denial of start, penalty or disqualification depending upon the nature and gravity of the violation.

11.6 The Organising Committee shall not be responsible for weapon, cylinder, regulator, sights, trigger, pellets, clothing, footwear or equipment malfunction during the competition. Shooters shall ensure that all equipment is safe, serviceable and in proper working condition before commencement of the match.

11.7 Any equipment or accessory considered unsafe, disruptive, non-compliant or unsuitable for range use may be prohibited by the Range Officer, Equipment Control Officer, Jury or Organising Committee.

12. Safety Rules

12.1 Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI), safe muzzle direction and all ISSF/NRAI safety requirements shall be strictly observed at all times inside the range premises.

12.2 An air weapon shall always be treated as loaded unless checked and declared safe. No shooter shall load, handle, aim or dry fire except at the designated firing point and only when authorised by the Range Officer.

12.3 Unsafe handling of any air weapon, violation of range commands, pointing the weapon in an unsafe direction, premature loading, or any conduct endangering persons or property may lead to warning, penalty, immediate disqualification or removal from the range.

12.4 All shooters, coaches, parents, accompanying persons and visitors shall strictly follow the instructions of the Range Officers, Jury and authorised officials. Non-compliance may result in removal from the competition area.

13. Conduct and Discipline

13.1 All participants shall adhere to the rules and regulations of the Championship.

13.2 Maintaining discipline and sportsmanship, both on and off the field, is mandatory.

13.3 Repeated damage to target frames, carrier systems, electronic targets or range equipment due to negligent shooting may attract warning, score penalty, disqualification or removal from the range at the discretion of the Jury/Organising Committee.

13.4 Any act of indiscipline, abusive behaviour, obstruction of officials, interference with another shooter, tampering with equipment or targets, or conduct unbecoming of a sportsperson may invite disciplinary action including disqualification.

13.5 The Protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF & NRAI Match Book. The Protest fee is Rs. 200/- and in case of appeal to Jury of Appeal, the protest fee is Rs. 500/-.

14. Departmental Ranking

Shooters of the Central Revenues Department viz. Customs, CGST and Income Tax, shall be ranked separately amongst themselves under “NR” and “ISSF” categories in Rifle and Pistol events.

14.1 Departmental category shall be open to serving and retired personnel of Customs, CGST and Income Tax Departments upon production of valid identity card, service proof, retirement proof or other documentation considered acceptable by IROSC.

14.2 Departmental ranking shall be prepared separately and shall not affect the open category results except to the extent specifically provided in this Circular for Finals or other recognised awards.

15. Refund Policy

15.1 Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event of non-participation by a competitor.

15.2 Refunds shall be made only if the competition is cancelled by the organizers.

15A. Medical Disclaimer

15A.1 Participants compete at their own risk. Organisers shall provide basic first-aid assistance at or near the venue, but shall not be liable for injury, illness, accident, loss or damage arising from participation, travel, equipment handling, range use or related activities.

15A.2 Every participant shall ensure that he/she is medically fit to participate in the Championship. Minors shall participate under the responsibility of their parents/guardians/coaches as applicable.

16. Amendments, Cancellation and Force Majeure

16.1 IROSC reserves the right to alter, modify, add, or delete any provision of this Circular or Tournament Schedule without prior notice.

16.2 Any decision taken by IROSC in this regard shall be final and binding on all participants.

16.3 No refund shall be admissible if the tournament is cancelled due to any order, direction, restriction, or notification issued by the Government of India, State Government, or any competent authority.

16.4 In the event of postponement or cancellation due to epidemic, pandemic, natural disaster, governmental restriction, administrative exigency, range unavailability or any other force majeure circumstance, entry fees may be adjusted against revised dates and shall ordinarily not be refundable.

16.5 IROSC may revise relays, event sequence, reporting time, firing point allocation, programme structure or administrative arrangements in the interest of safety, discipline and smooth conduct of the Championship.

17. False Information and Disqualification

17.1 Any “ISSF” athlete found participating under “NR” category shall be immediately disqualified.

17.2 If at any stage during or after the tournament it is found that a participant has furnished false information or documents, his/her participation shall be treated as null and void.

17.3 Any medals, trophies, certificates, prize money, or awards received by such participant shall be returned immediately.

17.4 IROSC may correct results, rankings, certificates or awards retrospectively if any false declaration, category error, ineligible participation or documentary discrepancy is discovered after publication of results.

18. Scoring

18.1 Air Rifle events under “ISSF” and “NR” will be conducted in “Decimal Scoring” and all other events on “Full-Ring scoring” basis.

18.2 Scores achieved in this Championship shall not be considered by NRAI or any State Rifle Association for qualification, ranking, grading, or any other official purpose.

19. Acceptance of Rules

Submission of an entry shall be deemed to constitute acceptance of all rules, regulations, terms, and conditions of the Championship by the participant.

19.1 In the case of minors, submission of entry shall also be deemed to have been made with the consent and responsibility of the parent/guardian/coach/institution concerned.

20. Finals & Prizes

20.1 The highest scorer (common for Men and Women in “Open” category including “Department” category) from all age groups in Rifle and Pistol events, will compete in “FINALS” conducted separately for “NR” and “ISSF” shooters (Total 24 finalists).

20.2 The “Finals” will be of 20 shots each. (Total Time – 25 min - 3 min sighting & preparation and 22 min match time). Air Rifle **Finals** under “ISSF” and “NR” will be conducted in “Decimal Scoring” and Air Pistol **Finals** on “Full-Ring scoring” basis.

20.3 The top three athletes in “NR” Rifle and Pistol and “ISSF” Rifle and Pistol in “Finals” will be given Cash Prize of Rs.5000/-, Rs.3000/- and Rs.2000/- respectively. (Total 12 athletes).

20.4 The Top Scorers in Air Rifle and Air Pistol (Combined for Men & Women athletes in “NR” and “ISSF” events separately in “Open” category including “Department” category) will be given “**Shri Pradeep Kumar Memorial Trophy**” & “**Shri Jaspal Rana Memorial Trophy**” respectively. This ranking will not include the scores of “Finals”.

20.5 Athletes coming 1st, 2nd and 3rd in all events will be given Gold, Silver and Bronze medals respectively.

20.6 Top scorer in “Para” category in Rifle and Pistol event will be given Cash Prize of Rs.3000/- each. (2 Athletes).

20.7 Participation certificates will be given to all athletes online.

20.8 Date, time and venue of Prize Distribution Ceremony shall be announced subsequent to the completion of the tournament.

21. Procedure in case of Tie

The ties will be broken as per ISSF/NRAI Match Book rules.

22. General Administrative Instructions

22.1 The Organising Committee may issue further administrative instructions for entry management, lane allotment, range discipline, score publication, prize distribution and movement within the venue.

22.2 Coaches, parents, guardians and accompanying persons shall remain outside the Field of Play and shall not interfere with competition conduct, scoring, equipment control, jury proceedings or range commands.

22.3 The competition area, preparation area, equipment control area and result area shall be accessed only as permitted by authorised officials.

22.4 The Organising Committee may deny entry or remove any person whose conduct is inconsistent with safety, discipline, dignity of the sport or smooth management of the Championship.
