

Thank you for your interest in the Prolific-Fund Carbon Offset Project Registry (“Registry”)! Our Administration Team (“A Team”) manages all document intake of Registry Participants, Project Participants, pre-registration and account creation (everything up unto Project Design).

If you're interested in engaging with Prolific-Fund, one of the most crucial steps is to conduct thorough research on our website, white papers, LinkedIn posts, and other relevant information about our company. Once you have familiarized yourself with our organization, we encourage you to express your skills and the scope of work for your project. We're looking for a co-founding engagement and project participants that demonstrates how you can add value to our team.

Once the A Team receives your expressed interest to be added as a Registry Participant for Prolific-Fund and submitted documents have been validated they will reply to you with an Assessment Report approving, denying or seeking corrective action. This is our formal ‘Know Your Customer’ process. If you would like to become a Registry Participant, please follow these steps:

How to become a Registry Participant with Prolific-Fund:

If you are interested in becoming a Registry Participant with The Prolific Fund Carbon Offset Registry, there are several ways to get involved.

1. Review the Intake Documents and Fee Schedule. Once you have reviewed these documents, submit a completed Intake Document via email.
2. Wait for verification by the Administration Team (“A Team”). The Registry Administrators will review all Registry Participant requests.
3. Once you are approved as a Registry Participant, you can choose to become a Project Developer. Submit your Project Concepts for review and consideration. If your Project Concept is approved, you will become the Authorized Representative for the project. You will then be able to work with Registry designated Project Portfolio Manager(s) in the appropriate sector(s), and project participants may begin working with the Registry on their Project Design.

What does being a Registry Participant mean?

There are many ways to get involved. Read below for descriptions.

- **Project funder, broker, aggregator or investor:** Submit your Business and Financial Assessment to the Registry. During a project’s Design Phase, you will then be invited to Stakeholder meetings as they relate to your decided Participant Role (pending the approval of the project’s Authorized Representative). You may then work with the Project

Participants to negotiate funding and terms of the project. This may include brokering Carbon Credits on exchange markets or to direct buyers, investing directly into the project or green/blue technology involved, purchasing the future rights to the carbon credits generated by the Project Activities, etc.

- **Voluntary Partner with the Registry:**

- **C.A.P. Syndicate:** If you are a company who is also making an impact in Environmental Concerns, Social Economic Empowerment, and/or The Good of Humanity, you may join the C.A.P. Syndicate. You can have your company's logo or introduction video, a brief summary of who you are and what you do posted to the website and a link back to your company's website posted below on Prolific-Fund's C.A.P. Syndicate webpage. You will be invited/consulted on relevant projects pending authorized representative approval on a per project bases.
- **Technical Board:** If you are an individual with technical expertise in a sector or several sectors, you can join our Technical Board. You may choose to be a publicly recognized Technical Board Participant and have your picture (optional), personal statement (optional) and contact info (optional) posted on the Prolific-Fund website or you may become a private Technical Board Participant and only the Project Participants of any projects you engage with will know who you are, while your information will be redacted from any public documents related to any projects you engage with.
- **Get involved with The Prolific Fund's socioeconomic impacts:** Whether you are a company or individual, all are welcome to get involved with our socioeconomic impact initiatives. There are several ways you can contribute, including:
 - **International Clean Water Initiative (ICWI):** Join our coalition and collaborate in our effort to implement technology and methods that contribute to the deacidification of ocean water, filter agricultural runoff and impact coastal ecosystem.
 - **Mentorship Program:** Help us make an educational impact on future leaders by offering your knowledge, recommendations, and giving real-world experience to young people. We want to prepare them for the green economy and give them access and opportunities that are currently locked to them.
 - **Gender Equality Program:** If you have a passion for the inclusivity and equality of women in the coming green economy that isn't business as usual, contact us to get involved.
