Grandchildren in Pease Family Diaries Dairies – 1958-1970

Compiled by Art Pease, 2025

There are no existing diaries from 1953 thru 1957, nor either diary from 1966. The 50s ones must have gone in the fire or been lost, as I expect they were with the others. We are very fortunate that so many were 'rescued!' I don't know what happened to the 1966 ones.

In the entries, Ma's are noted at [T], while Dad's are all the others. [S] means Sunday. As one might expect, most of the entries here are from Ma, especially in the early years. I have not included Dad's if they were short and also covered in Ma's comments. I have tried to find all mentions but may have missed a few. Given Dad's 'just the facts, Ma'am' style, I expect that the kids may have been at the farm, especially helping with sugaring, more than he mentions.

[From Harry, 3/3/25: "Dad and I chopped quite a bit of green feed down at Gregoires (sp?) in West Rumney. We used Pete Thomson's flail chopper and his truck and Grandpas's truck. We would take Pete a load each time for the use of his equipment. Dad chopped and I drove truck. I drove Pete's truck and Dad drove Grandpa's.
