## J ohn B. Chase Orford, N.H. 1860 Accounts

## Excerpts Transcribed by Art Pease 2014

[This is a record of his accounts for the year, in a small black diary labeled 1860. Much of this is as J ohn wrote it, with his spelling and with some paraphrasing and leaving out of connecting words. Most info is here, with a bit left out when redundant andlor couldn't be read. He writes 'Cr' many times, which I think is 'credit', in that he is keeping track of what he owes or what is owed to him. He also writes 'Cash' and it is not always clear if he is paying it or receiving it. Sometimes John notes paid at the time of the item and at other times he goes back and notes 'paid' - I have listed these occasions as [paid] or whatever he actually wrote.]
