JNU MENDENHALL LOOP ROAD

The Alaska Department of Transportation in cooperation with Secon, Inc., is working to repave Mendenhall Loop Road from the Egan Drive/Mendenhall Loop intersection to Trinity Drive. Project work includes minor structural improvements, replacement of a fish culvert, ADA improvements, traffic markings, and signage.

The Mendenhall Loop Road project is scheduled to shut down for the winter on during the first week of November, 2022. Spring startup of the 2023 construction season is planned for May or June to complete remaining work. Project completion is estimated to be June 30, 2023.



When construction is present, motorists should expect slight delays in the flow of traffic. Pedestrians and bicyclists should look for sidewalk detours. The construction contractor, Secon, will work to accommodate all road users. Traffic conditions and the construction schedule will be updated regularly on the project website. As a reminder: Please use caution when traveling in work zones. Watch for and follow direction from construction signs and flaggers when present throughout the construction zone.
