FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS



In September 2019, City Council approved the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Budget with the new budget to be implemented on October 1, 2019. The approved Budget for all City Funds (General Fund, Water/Wastewater, Debt Fund and Economic Development Fund) is \$7,162,927.00. The current tax rate of \$0.3778 will lower to \$0.3545, which is a decrease of \$0.0233. Also, the total appraised value of all properties is \$465,820,561, an increase of \$7,162,927 from last year due to new construction. This budget continues to be conservative and cost-effective because we watch our expenditures very closely with savings in mind for you, our taxpayers. Also, an updated five (5) year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) outlines estimated costs for vehicles, equipment, personnel, facilities, and programs. The CIP is a blueprint to help guide City planning efforts and outline funding options and time frames for major capital expenses as the City grows.

The FY 2019-2018 Budget has 19 full-time and 2 part-time positions to effectively carry out the budget plan.

Street Improvements and repairs will continue into the new fiscal year through our street program. In this new budget year, the following streets will be repaired: Cliffside Drive, Meadow Lane, Westgate Drive, Fairview Addition, Cedar Bluff Court, Creek Side Drive, Bear Creak Road, and Underwood to Pine to City limits. The City of Aledo is 1 of 9 cities that was selected for its third grant that will fund an additional sidewalk project from City Hall west on Old Annetta Road. This project is expected to be completed in 2020.

In the new budget, the General Fund—Parks Department and Aledo Economic Development Corporation Reserves will be used to construct a covered stage in Aledo Commons.

The Library appropriation will increase from \$35,000 to \$40,000 due to their growing needs.

In April, the City and City Council hired the Velocity Group, an experience design firm, to help update its planned, managed and intentional Strategic Plan for the future of Aledo. In July, the firm's executives visited the City of Aledo and conducted several meetings to gather ideas and valuable feedback from Mayor Marshall, City Council, city board members and staff, selected Aledo businesses, Aledo ISD school superintendent and board, churches, and area business and community organizations that impact Aledo. The Velocity Group is heavily focused on deepening the value of existing Aledo, and growing its commercial opportunities with tools to market the City, as well as create its distinct footprint and "DNA of Place". Mayor Marshall agreed that "Aledo has a lot of chapters to write" and is excited to hear the Velocity Group's proposal at their second visit to Aledo in November.
