Pro Tip:

Pro Tip:

When installing a zipper or creating buttonholes, always test your technique on a fabric scrap first! This gives you a chance to adjust your stitch length, tension, and presser foot without risking your final piece. Keep a small bin of leftover fabric just for practice runs—your future projects will thank you.

 Pro Tip:

When working with leather or vinyl, skip the pins! They leave permanent holes. Instead, use clips or double-sided sewing tape to hold pieces together while sewing. Also, a non-stick or Teflon presser foot can make stitching much smoother and prevent sticking or skipped stitches. And if you're practicing tailoring techniques, always press as you go—steam and shaping tools (like a tailor's ham or seam roll) are your secret weapons for crisp seams and professional-looking results.
