Materials Needed:

- Cotton fabric (small scraps work great)
- Embroidery machine and supplies (stabilizer, thread, hoop, etc.)
- Rice or flaxseed (for filler)
- Scissors or rotary cutter
- Ruler or measuring tape
- Sewing machine (optional for assembly)

Instructions:

Step 1: Choose Your Fabric and Design

1. Select a durable, natural fabric like cotton. Avoid synthetic materials, as they can melt in the microwave.
2. Decide on a design for the embroidery. Winter motifs like snowflakes, mittens, or simple geometric patterns work well.

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Step 2: Prepare the Fabric

1. Cut two squares or rectangles of fabric, each about 4" x 4" or the size you prefer for your hand warmers.
2. Hoop one piece of fabric with stabilizer, ensuring it's taut and smooth.

Step 3: Embroider the Design

1. Load your chosen design onto your embroidery machine.
2. Stitch out the design on the fabric. Ensure the embroidery is centered and fits within the hand warmer size.
3. Once completed, remove the fabric from the hoop and carefully trim away the excess stabilizer.

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Step 4: Assemble the Hand Warmer

1. Place the embroidered fabric and the plain fabric piece right sides together.
2. Sew around the edges, leaving about a 1-inch opening for turning and filling. Use a 1/4-inch seam allowance.
3. Trim the corners to reduce bulk, being careful not to cut the stitches.

Step 5: Turn and Fill

1. Turn the fabric right side out through the opening. Use a point-turner or the end of a pen to push out the corners.
2. Fill the pouch about 2/3 full with rice or flaxseed. For added scent, mix dried lavender or a few drops of essential oil with the filler.

Step 6: Close the Opening

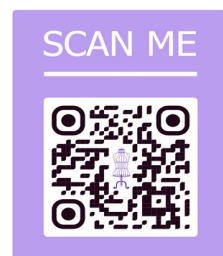
1. Fold the raw edges of the opening inward and sew it shut using a needle and thread or your sewing machine.

Step 7: Heat and Enjoy

1. To use, heat the hand warmers in the microwave for 20-30 seconds. Test the warmth before handling, and enjoy cozy hands all winter long!
