## **Neuropsychology Appointment Information**

Hello and welcome to my practice,

My assessment process starts with a consultation meeting, which allows us to discuss your referral concerns, discuss the assessment process, and the next steps. There is a charge of \$150 for the consultation meeting, deducted from the total assessment fee if you choose to move forward with testing. I will send you several forms before our initial consultation meeting, including the estimated costs, consent forms, and a brief referral questionnaire.

We can meet by virtual telehealth or in-person:

**Virtual telehealth appointments** involve the use of audio and video technology to connect directly with Dr. Ambler at your convenience. Plan to take the virtual visit from a private space using a laptop or desktop computer with a strong internet connection. You may need to download WebEx or Zoom before the appointment. Please refer to *Healthcare from your home document* for guidance on setting up a WebEx account.

**In-person appointments**: My office is located in downtown Los Altos, *340 Second Street, Suite 8; Los Altos, California 94022*. Free parking is located in the back of Whitney Street. You can wait in the lobby when you arrive.

The typical cost of an assessment ranges from \$2250 to \$4350. The fee includes the consultation meeting, record review, neuropsychological assessment, written report, feedback session, and follow-up. The neuropsychological evaluation report outlines the assessment findings, strengths/weaknesses, diagnosis, recommendations, treatment options, interventions, school accommodations, and more.

Also, please note that I am an Out-of-Network provider. It is recommended that you contact your insurance company if you wish to seek reimbursement.
