WHEN I READ THE BIBLE, I CAN...

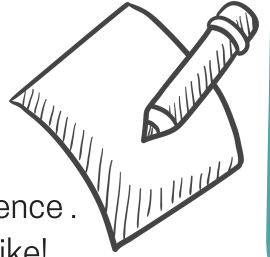


DRAW IT

WRITE IT

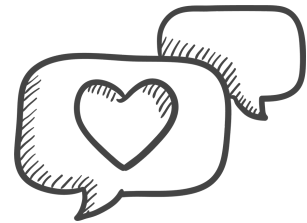
Write a favorite verse or sentence.

IMAGINE IT

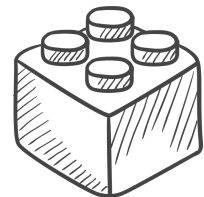
Imagine myself in the story.

or build it with blocks.

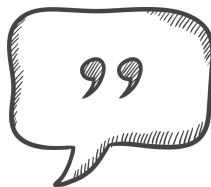


SING IT
