

Case Study: Queen Margaret University

Background

Theorise was initially asked by Queen Margaret University to supply note-takers to support students with a range of specific learning difficulties including differing physical impairments. The first step was to meet with the client to gain a detailed understanding of the role, identify all key requirements in respect of person specification, timescales, numbers, and contingencies. Theorise are now responsible for providing a range of key roles to assist with the academic progression of students through further education.

Key Challenges:

- · Fragmented attendance patterns depending on student timetables.
- · Matching scribe/note taker with students' subjects.
- · Matching skills required whether physical or academic.
- Enhanced recruitment process necessary key areas of consideration included the type and level of support required, the subject and level of study, both academic and intellectual.

Solutions to Challenges:

- Detailed telephone pre-screening and face to face interviews conducted by fully qualified senior
