What Not To Bring:

Valuables such as jewelry and large amounts of money should not be brought to camp.

Brush Creek Campgrounds are a Drug Free Environment. Only prescribed medical prescriptions for the camper are allowed. Upon arrival, medication should be given to the camp nurse for proper administration.

DRESS CODE: Wear modest clothing, keeping in mind the spiritual nature of the camp. It is required for all campers to wear footwear everywhere on the grounds.

- All tops must have straps on both shoulders and should cover your belly.
- Swimsuit Policy: Please bring modest swimwear consistent with a church sponsored activity.
