


Psalms of The People – Morning Glory Nation

and doors that are not Yours to open.


In the midst of the unknown, one thing I know for sure:

Every day, I seek your peace.


LORD, you told me to call on you and you would answer. So I look to you for help, I look to you for strength, I look to you for wisdom, I look to you for direction. I look to you.
