Each month we feature an artist after our member business meeting. Our first Demo of the year was with charismatic acrylic and mixed media artist, **Jemal Hayes**. He delighted us with a fast paced pallet knife, paint brush, and gold leaf live painting demonstration.



He often starts with a charcoal drawing which is worked over with gesso, paint, plaster and sometimes crayon or pastel- creating different textures and layers.

"When people view my art I want them to be drawn in and their curiosities piqued. I want them to take their own journey, ask their own questions and most of all, form their own conclusions. I want them to meander through the painting and ponder what the thought

process must have been like when this painting was taking on life. When I paint I allow my subconscious to take over which allows total self-expression and freedom.
