Demos at the Library 2022



Stefanie Pollack thrilled us with her fluid watercolor strokes this January. She demonstrated how to use the negative space with color when painting white flowers.

She is an award-winning, Florida watercolor artist who loves to make people feel happy with her bright colors and uplifting themes!

She began art lessons at the age of 12 with the Art Director of Ford Motor Company in Michigan and then went on to study at Texas Woman's University, North Texas State and Wayne State University. She also attended workshops in Florida and San Miguel de Allende, Mexico.

In 1984, She began showing her work professionally at local art festivals. Today she participates in more than 20 festivals around the country, teaching workshops as well as showcasing her work in galleries from New York to Key West. We were very lucky to have her demonstrate for us!

In Februrary **Karen Leffel-Massengill** amazed us with her oils. She painted for us a landscape showing us how to focus on the value relationships correctly to maximize the effect of light.

She has enjoyed immense success on the art show circuit, being accepted into many of the top art shows in the nation to include Coconut Grove, Ann Arbor State Street Art Fair, Ann Arbor South University Art Fair, Winter Park Sidewalk Festival and Artigras. She has won numerous awards at these shows and has been selected as the poster artist for five different shows.

In 2018, Leffel-Massengill was awarded second place in the All Florida Show "Sweet" shown at the Elliott Museum in Stuart Florida, first place at the annual Backus Gallery competition for her piece titled "Double Vision" and as a national winner in the national competition sponsored by Plein Air Magazine in the the

bi-monthly "animal" category with her painting titled "Female Cow Bird."





Member, Mallo Bisset came and entertained us in March painting an underwater scene in oil only using a palette knife. We enjoyed watching her paint while listening to her interesting stories. You are always sure to pick up a few life skills from her.

She always specializes in palette knife oil paintings. Her paintings are textured and almost always full of color. Her artwork celebrates the things that make her happy. While her subject matter does vary, she is greatly influenced by love of color, animals, and nature. She has always lived close to the sea, so water and the color blue seem to be a part of her and often make it onto her canvas.
