

Did you know that the city offers a heavy trash pick-up service? It's through Republic Services and is included in our monthly fee. Call the city to make an appointment. All appointments will be scheduled on a Wednesday.

Heavy Trash: Appliances, hot water heaters and other white goods such as washing machines, driers, and dishwashers. All items must be placed within 5 feet of the curb. All branches and tree limbs must be cut to 3 feet lengths and tied in small bundles that can be lifted and handled by a single person. Bundles should be no larger than 18 inches in diameter and weight no more than 40 pounds.

Refrigeration Units: Refrigerators, air conditioners, freezers, or items that contain freon (CFC), by law, must have the gas removed by a licensed technician and be red tagged prior to collection.

Restricted Items: Tires, solvents, paint, petroleum products, pool chemicals, fertilizer, herbicides, pesticides, hazardous material/chemicals, logs or stumps, car batteries, soil, rocks, concrete, carpet or padding, construction material, medical waste, medical sharps, and closed containers.
