Show By-Laws

REVISED 2008

1. CARE AND RESPONSIBILITY

- 1.1 The Club will take all reasonable care, but accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to any exhibit or equipment.
- 1.2 All exhibits must be the BONE FIDE property of the exhibitor.
- 1.3 No bird is to be removed until after the presentation of prizes and awards unless approved by the Show Manager.
- 1.4 Only birds entered as exhibits will be allowed into the show hall.
- 1.5 Door Stewards have the right to deny entry or exit or any bird or cage to or from the hall while the show is in progress.
- 1.6 **NO JUDGING STICKS OR SIMILAR DEVICES** will be permitted in the show hall except by judges appointed for this show.
- 1.7 The Show Manager has the power to remove a distressed/diseased bird from the bench.

2. SHOW ENTRIES

- 2.1 Entries must be in duplicate and accompanied by a stamped addressed envelope and the appropriate entry fee. See LOCAL CONDITIONS AND RULES 8.1; 8.2.
- 2.2 Email/Postal entries are encouraged.
- 2.3 The Secretary and/or Show Manager have the power to reject any entry.
- 2.4 All mutations are to be shown A.O.V. or A.O.C. (Any other variety Any other colour). Unless specified in a class.
- 2.5 Parentage of all hybrids is to be stated on the entry form. The sticker provided by the Secretary should be placed on the bottom right hand corner of the show cage.
- 2.6 No late entries or reclassing of entries will be permitted on the morning of the show.
- 2.7 Notice of withdrawal of any entry is to be made to the Secretary **on arrival at the show**. Cage stickers for withdrawals **SHOULD BE RETURNED.**

3. BENCHING

- 3.1 Each exhibit must be staged in an accepted standard show cage, which should be in a neat and clean condition.
- 3.2 Each cage is to be complete with standard drinker and sufficient seed for the duration of the show.
- 3.3 The care of birds is the responsibility of the **INDIVIDUAL OWNER**.
- 3.4 The sticker is to be attached to the bottom left hand corner of the show cage (see 2.5 for hybrids).
- 3.5 Floor covering requirement see LOCAL CONDITIONS AND RULES 8.5
- 3.6 **Benching of exhibits see** LOCAL CONDITIONS AND RULES 8.3.

4. JUDGING

- 4.1 Open judging conditions will apply.
- 4.2 See LOCAL CONDITIONS AND RULES 8.4 for the time that judging will start.
- 4.3 The name of the trainee judge is to be printed in the schedule, along with the other judge. No judging stick or similar device is to be used by the trainee.
- 4.4 Show Managers and Chief Stewards are to request that birds be judged on judging stands provided.
- 4.5 Judges are required to judge, accepted standard show cages as accepted by the club officials in a neat and clean condition.
- 4.6 Hybrids H1-H5 & P247-P256 are not eligible to stand for Grand Champion.

5. YOUNG BIRDS

A young bird must be rung with a 2018 year ring, coloured RED OR a 2019 year ring, coloured BLACK and must have been bred by the exhibitor.

- 5.2 Proof of ownership of major winners **WILL BE REQUIRED** and **WILL BE CHECKED** by the Show Manager or persons appointed by him/her. The ownership of any bird can be checked by the Show Manager (see 1.2).
- 5.3 EXHIBITORS WHO FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THIS RULE (5.2) WILL AUTOMATICALLY FORFEIT ANY TROPHIES OR AWARDS AT THIS SHOW.
- 5.4 The proof of ownership records may include: authorised ring register, receipt showing ring numbers, breeding register or other official documentation.
- 5.5 See COMPLAINTS AND DISQUALIFICATIONS 6.4.

6. COMPLAINTS AND DISQUALIFICATIONS

- 6.1 All complaints should be directed to the Show Manager by 2pm on the day of the Show.
- 6.2 A \$20 protest fee must accompany any protest. The fee is refundable if the complaint is justified.
- 6.3 Disqualification will occur when:
 - a) birds are entered in the wrong class;
 - b) cages are deemed to be marked cages by a judge, and
 - c) **bought young birds** are shown in YOUNG BIRD Classes.

In all cases the judge's decision is final.

- 6.4 In the case of 6.3 c), the exhibitor will be disqualified and will be suspended from showing at an affiliated Club until the end of the following year's Show season.
- 6.5 The decision of the Show Manager will be final in any dispute that occurs on Show day. The Executive of the Club may assist the Show Manager if required.

7. FINALISATION OF SHOW

7.1 No birds can be taken from the Show hall until all exhibitors are satisfied that they have their own birds. The Show Manager will then permit all exhibitors to leave.

8. LOCAL CONDITIONS AND RULES

- 8.1 Entry Fees: \$1 per cage. (Maximum entry fees \$30. No charge for juniors.)
- 8.2 Closing date for entries is Thurs 30th May, 2019.
- 8.3 Benching of exhibits
 - a) Local Exhibitors: 7.30am
 - b) Visiting Exhibitors: 8.00am

(Specify any special arrangements.)

- 8.4 Judging will commence at:8.30am
- 8.5 Floor covering guide: Budgerigars Budgie Mix

Canaries Paper OR Canary seed

Finches Finch Mix
Parrots Parrot Mix
Ouail/Dove Seed Mix

Appropriate seed is recommended by the Association.

- 8.6 This Show does <u>NOT</u> use the Association schedule for budgerigars.


9. PRESENTATION OF EXHIBITS

- 1. Items for sale can be lodged between 1 p.m. Saturday 1st June and 10am Sunday 2nd June, 2019.
- 2. No birds or other items will be accepted for sale after 12 am Sunday 2nd June.
- 3. Ideally FOUR birds per box or adequate perch space and cage size appropriate for the number & bird type.
- 4. Must be sufficient seed in each box for duration of Show.
- 5. Must be a suitable water container in each box.
- 6. No quail will be accepted for sale.
- 7. Birds entered in Show cannot also be lodged in the Sales section.
- 8. Sellers must nominate sale price, and \$1.00 / Bird entry fee for the sale.
- 9. Sellers and Purchasers of native birds must notify Aviary Registration Number if required.
- 10. Birds can be purchased from 1p.m. Saturday 1st June, until 2p.m. Sunday 2nd June 2019.
- 11. Birds purchased must be immediately taken from the hall, or can be retained at rear of Sales section tagged with Purchaser's name until ready to be taken from the hall by Purchaser.
- 12. Sellers or their representatives must sell the birds similar to Orange or Gunnedah sales.

 The Orana Avicultural Society bears no responsibility for the selling of birds.
- 13. The Orana Avicultural Society can reject any sale item if considered unsafe, unclean/in poor condition or not complying with our code of practice as displayed at our show.






