Summer Program 2024:

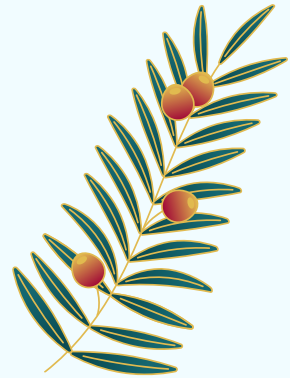
- *Completed Kindergarten - completed 7th grade
- *7:30am-5:30pm
- *\$300 per child (Includes all meals, activities, and fees)
- *Dates are June 3rd-August
- *Payments can be made beginning in January
- *We will have weekly field trips, and parents will receive a program calendar prior to the beginning of the summer program.

After School Program 2024:

- *Kindergarten - 7th grade
- *3:00pm-5:30pm
- Starts the first day of school and ends the last day of school.
- *We follow the school calendar.
- *Cost \$20 per child per week. This fee is owed even if your child does not attend. Payments will be taken at the Community Center. We accept cash, check, and card.
- *Buses will drop off children at the Community Center.
- *Each child will receive an afternoon snack before completing homework. After homework, they will participate in an activity.
