ORDINANCE NO. 105-88

ORDINANCE ADOPTING STATE MISDEMEANORS, VIOLATIONS AND

OFFENSES AS MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORDOVA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Any person, firm or corporation committing an offense within the corporate limits of the City of Cordova, Alabama, or within the police jurisdiction thereof, which is declared by a law or laws of the State of Alabama now existing or hereafter enacted to be a misdemeanor, shall be guilty of an offense against the City of Cordova, Alabama.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation committing an offense within the corporate limits of the City of Cordova, Alabama, or within the police jurisdiction thereof, which is declared by a law or laws of the State of Alabama now existing or hereafter enacted to be a violation shall be guilty of an offense against the city of Cordova, Alabama.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation committing an offense within the corporate limits of the City of Cordova, Alabama, or within the police jurisdiction thereof, which offense is defined by that part of Section 13A-1-2 (1) Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, pertaining to any law or local law or ordinance of a political subdivision of this state (which is not a felony) and which offense is not declared by a law or laws of the State of Alabama now existing or hereafter enacted to be a misdemeanor or violation, shall be guilty of an offense against the City of Cordova, Alabama.

Section 4. Any person, firm or corporation found to be in violation of Sections One (1), Two (2) or Three (3) of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars

(\$500.00) and/or imprisoned or sentenced to hard labor for the City for a period not exceeding six (6) months, at the discretion of the Judge trying the case.

Section 5. Any ordinance heretofore adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Cordova, Alabama, which is in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. If any part, section or subdivision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such holding shall not be construed to invalidate or render void the remainder of this ordinance, which shall continue in full force and effect notwithstanding such holding.

Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective on March, 1988.
