AN ORDINANCE SETTING FEE FOR TAPPING ON
SEWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF CORDOVA, ALABAMA


BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Cordova, Alabama, that there is hereby established a fee of \$200.00, for tapping on the City of Cordova, Alabama, sewer system.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that a consideration will be made for households with an income of \$6,000.00 per year or less, with proof of income to be required of the subscriber.
