

CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORDOVA, ALABAMA

ORDINANCE NO. 05-2022

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO CHARGE THE FIVE-YEAR ADJUSTMENT TO MUNICIPAL BUSINESS LICENSE ISSUANCE FEES.

WHEREAS, the Alabama Department of Revenue (“ALDOR”) is required by law to analyze the U.S. Department of Labor’s Producer Price Index and determine how much municipal business license issuance fees should increase every five license years;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-51-90 of the *Code of Alabama* (1975) and Departmental Rule 810-8-5-.15, every five years, ALDOR is responsible for establishing and publishing adjustments to municipal business license issuance fees, as well as, notifying all municipalities and the Alabama League of Municipalities of any such fee increase no later than November 30 preceding the affected license year;

WHEREAS, based on the U.S. Department of Labor’s Producer Price Index, ALDOR states that municipal business license issuance fees remain or may be adjusted to a maximum amount of fourteen dollars (\$14.00) at the discretion of each municipality, for the license year beginning January 1, 2023;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Cordova, Alabama, while in regular session on Tuesday, September 13, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. as follows:

1. The City of Cordova, Alabama (the “Town”) elects to charge the maximum amount of fourteen dollars (\$14.00) for municipal business license issuance fees.
2. This increase will not take effect until the license year beginning January 1, 2023.


