

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FINES FOR CASES WHICH ARE NOT STATE MISDEMEANORS,  
VIOLATIONS OR OFFENSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CORDOVA,  
ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Any person, firm or corporation committing an offense within the corporate limits of the City of Cordova, Alabama, or within the police jurisdiction therefor, which is in violation of an ordinance of the City of Cordova, Alabama, now existing or hereafter enacted, shall upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). In addition thereto, any person so convicted, may be imprisoned or sentenced to hard labor for the City of Cordova, Alabama for a period not exceeding six months, at the discretion of the Court trying the case; provided, however, that no penalty shall consist of a fine or sentence of imprisonment exceeding the maximum fine or sentence of imprisonment established under State law for the commission of substantially similar offense.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. The provisions of this ordinance are cumulative and shall not be construed to repeal or supersede any laws not inconsistent herewith.

SECTION 3. If any part of an ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the parts which remain.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective on the seventh day of June, 1982.


