

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-02

AN ORDINANCE SETTING OUT
PROCEDURES FOR THE ENFORCEMENT
OF ORDINANCE NO. 104-80.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY
OF CORDOVA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That a picture shall be taken of each dog impounded under the provisions of Ordinance No. 104-80, with the date, time, place, and person impounding the dog. The City of Cordova Police Department will record this.
2. A notification of the establishment of Walker County Humane Society will be posted on a bulletin board in the city hall, and a description of animals impounded will be placed on said bulletin board for the purpose of keeping the citizens of Cordova informed.
3. Copies of said Ordinance No. 104-80 shall be posted in several places in the City of Cordova, and shall be kept by members of the Police Department and the Street Superintendent.
4. A dog that is impounded to the Walker County Humane Society Jasper, Al. will become their property and they will either adopt, or terminate the dog depending on if the dog is vicious or not.

_____ Through _____, and from year to year thereafter.

5. The animals will be taken to the Walker County Humane Society in Jasper, Alabama.
6. Notification in the Daily Mountain Eagle, Jasper, Alabama, will be given to the Citizens of Walker County regarding the adoption of said dog ordinance, and stating that dogs without rabies vaccination tags will be picked up, and that a copy of said ordinance may be obtained at the City Hall, Cordova, Alabama, for \$_____.
7. The persons designated for animal control shall be the Chief of Police, all City Policeman, Street Superintendent, City Street Employees, Walker County Humane Society assistant, water and gas employees, and anyone else designated by the mayor, chief of police, and council.
