

ORDINANCE NO. 103-88

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE MANUFACTURE, SALE AND DISCHARGE  
OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY OF CORDOVA AND ITS POLICE JURISDICTION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF  
CORDOVA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

In accordance with the provisions of State Code of Alabama  
1975, 11-44-7, 11-44-17 and 11-44-18, the City Commission of  
the City of Cordova hereby adopts the following:

Article 17 of the Southern Standard Fire Prevention Code 1974  
Edition, Adopted by reference "ORDINANCE TO ADOPT STANDARD  
CODES" adopted August 5, 1975, is hereby amended as follows:

Article 17.03 (b.) Except as hereinafter provided, it shall  
be lawful for any person to possess, store, to offer for sale,  
expose for sale, sell at retail, or use or explode Class C  
fireworks; provided that the Fire Chief shall have power to  
adopt reasonable rules and regulations for the granting of  
permits for supervised public displays of fireworks by a  
jurisdiction, fair associations, amusement parks, other  
organizations or for the use of fireworks by artisans in  
pursuit of their trade. Every such use or display shall be  
handled by a competent operator approved by the Fire Department  
and shall be of such character and so located, discharged or  
fired so as not to be hazardous to property or endanger any  
person.

It shall be unlawful to sell fireworks of any type or kind  
to any person under eighteen (18) years of age.
