Born in Austin, Texas on February 4th, Michele holds a degree in Aeronautical and Aerospace Engineering and has 45 years experience as a professional artist, 41 of which spent as a sculptor and founder, operating his own full service fine art sculpture studio and lost wax bronze casting foundry



Michael has been President Emeritus of the Texas Society of Sculptors since 1989 and sits on the Board or Directors of that organization. Bronze sculptures created by Michael can be found in private and corporate collections from The Royal palace in National Museum of Medicine.
