Coronado Tennis Association Code of Conduct

Exemplary behavior is expected of all individuals in Coronado Tennis Association (CTA) events and activities. Participants are expected to be courteous and respectful of others at all times.

It is considered unbecoming conduct if any CTA member, while at a CTA-sponsored event, engages in

- (A) Abusive display of temper
- (B) Rude, loud, abusive or threatening language or taunting
- (C) Profanity, obscene language or gestures
- (D)Racquet throwing
- (E) Behavior that could jeopardize the safety of persons or cause damage to property

Any of the above may be considered as grounds for ejection from the CTA event and/or cancellation of CTA membership. At the discretion of the CTA Board of Directors, his/her membership fee will be reimbursed in the event that their CTA membership is revoked. Reinstatement may be appealed to the board.
