

AMENDMENT TO THE  
CORONADO TENNIS ASSOCIATION BYLAWS

December 21, 2008

ARTICLE III. DIRECTORS, Section 1, as amended by majority vote of the general membership of the CORONADO TENNIS ASSOCIATION at its annual meeting of the general membership on December 21, 2008, shall read as follows:

ARTICLE III. DIRECTORS

Section 1. The Board of Directors shall consist of nine (9) members. The term of a Director shall be three (3) years, except in the first election after the adoption of these Bylaws Directors may be elected in irregular number or for shorter terms in order to establish the rhythm of up to four (4) new Directors each subsequent year. Directors shall be allowed to serve more than one (1) consecutive term if nominated and subsequently elected (amended 12/09/01).

ARTICLE IX. DUES AND MEMBERSHIPS, Section 3, as amended by majority vote of the general membership of the CORONADO TENNIS ASSOCIATION at its annual meeting of the general membership on December 21, 2008, shall read as follows:

Section 3. The dues are payable annually in advance and are as follows:

ARTICLE VI. MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS, Section 1, as amended by majority vote of the general membership of the CORONADO TENNIS ASSOCIATION at its annual meeting of the general membership on November 16, 2010, shall read as follows:

ARTICLE VI. MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. The annual meeting of the members of the Association shall be held once a year. The President shall fix the time and place of the meeting and instruct the Secretary to give timely notice of the meeting to all members. Such notice shall be in writing, be mailed, clearly setting forth the time and place of the meeting, the purpose for which called, and the list of candidates to be voted upon for the seats on the Board of Directors.

All other articles of the CORONADO TENNIS ASSOCIATION Bylaws in effect as of January 1999 shall remain in force and effect as currently written.
