#### **MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER 1ST MEETING:**

#### **MEETING CALLED TO ORDER BY DEBRA SEYMOUR OUR PRESIDENT AT 3:50:**

STUDENT COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVES BRYN STEPHENS, MAGGIE BASSINGER AND LAUREN SHOFFNER WERE PRESENT. THEY WANTED TO THANK THE PTSA FOR HOSTING THE EVENT ON SEPT. 20TH. THEY GAVE SOME INPUT ABOUT FLYERS THAT MIGHT BE FUN TO HAVE FOR NEXT YEARS SUNRISE. IN ALL ALL THE STUDENTS HAD A NICE TIME AND APPRECIATED THE EVENT. THEY ALSO DISCUSSED THAT MONDAY OCTOBER 24TH WAS WHEN THEY WERE GOING TO HAVE TRUNK OR TREAT.
