
## **Jesus' Right to Rule**

## Is Jesus for Real? Mathematical Proof!

For 48 similar prophecies to come true in **ONE** person is 1 in 10 to the 157th power. (I didn't have time to do all the zeros but you get the picture).

There are 78 major prophesies and almost 300 minor prophesies regarding the Messiah that God would send to this earth. God didn't want us miss the Messiah He would send to mankind.
