GO, FIND

The French philosopher, Descartes, is famous for saying, “I think, therefore I am.” He also said, that “Good sense is, of all things among men, the most equally distributed; for every one thinks himself so abundantly provided with it, that those even who are the most difficult to satisfy in everything else, do not usually desire a larger measure of this quality than they already possess.” In a dry way, he was saying that people are generally not really concerned about if what they say makes good sense.

Children sometimes have a capacity for good sense that even professedly smart adults don't at all have. If you've ever been in charge of little ones — maybe, on a snow day — you know what a challenge it can be to keep them entertained and avoiding “stir crazy.” The next time you have that job, try playing the game, Go/Find. Go find blue things; round things; things with corners.

Suppose you instructed the children, “Go find made, m-ad-e, things.” They would point to TVs, smart phones, couches, chairs, floors they're walking on, toilet paper, and the cardboard center it's wound around.

The Bible (Romans 1:19,20), says “what may be known of God is evident to men, because God has shown it to men”; and, “since the creation of the world God's invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that men are without excuse.”

Even with little of life's experience, children can intuitively tell whether a thing is “made”; but, not necessarily “big people.” Imagine playing Go/Find with the writers of some Biology books — such as, those used in our schools to teach Evolution. It would be so cool to send them into a lab where human brains, eyes, hearts, and such are kept in jars of formaldehyde; and then say, “Go find made things.” I suppose they might point to the jars and say “Oh. Made things”; but, not the amazing human organs stored inside. That makes no sense at all.




