IMMEDIATE RESPONSE REQUIRED!

The Bible is filled with passages which encourage an immediate response to God's offer of salvation both by example and direct statement. In every case of conversion recorded in the book of Acts those who responded in obedience to the gospel did so without delay. The account of Acts chapter two shows that those who heard the gospel preached and who gladly received the instructions given them were baptized "and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls" (Acts 2:37-41). When Philip preached Jesus to the Ethiopian Eunuch, the Eunuch was baptized as soon as they came to a "certain water" (Acts 8:36-39). The infamous persecutor of the church Saul came face to face with Jesus as he traveled from Jerusalem to Damascus and was instructed by the Lord to go into the city and wait for one to come and tell him what he must do. As soon as the penitent Saul received the instructions for which he waited he was baptized into Christ (Acts 9:1 -18; 22:16). After Paul and Silas had taught the jailor and his family "the Word of the Lord" the Bible tells us, "And he took them the same hour of the night and washed their stripes. And immediately he and all his family were baptized" (Acts 16:33).

Each of these examples show an immediate response to the gospel. There was no

hesitation, no postponement, and no waiting. These people were lost in sin. Each recognized that without an immediate response they would remain lost and without hope.

When Paul, by inspiration of the Holy Spirit, wrote to the church in Corinth, he admonished them not to receive the grace of God in vain, "For He says: 'In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you.' Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation" (2 Corinthians 6:1-2). The principle taught in this passage applies with equal force to both non-Christians and erring Christians. No one should put off taking the steps necessary to receiving God's forgiveness.

It is extremely sad when someone waits too long to respond to God's offer of salvation. None of us have a lease on life. Death can come and it can come quickly. None are assured of tomorrow. "Whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away" (James 4:14). Dear friend, God loves you. His great desire is your salvation (2 Peter 3:9). However, your immediate response is required! "today, if you will hear His voice, do not harden your hearts" (Hebrews 4:7).


