PRESSING TOWARD THE MARK By: Bradley Smith

When someone is crossing a swinging bridge thousands of feet above the ground, they are always told before all else "do not look down." They are told to keep their eyes forward on that desired location. Philippians 3:13-14 discusses the mark, or goal, toward which all Christians press. Just as the one walking across that bridge must remained focused, we must remained focused. We cannot have one eye on Heaven and one eye on the world because a double minded man is unstable in all his ways (James 1:8). When the man on the bridge looks down, he gets wobbly and starts to lose focus on his goal. Before long, he has fallen from that great height. When I think I have one eye on the world and one on God, it is not long before I find myself in the depths of sin. We need to set our sights on things above, not on things of the earth (Col. 3:2), because the things of the earth will be destroyed (2 Pet. 3:10), and the things of this world cannot abide with God (1 John 2:15-17). Let us press toward that mark with minds focused solely upon our Redeemer and His commands. Let us run this race and fight this fight with our ultimate Example in mind (Heb. 12:1-2).

NO OTHER FOUNDATION By: Bradley Smith

t is estimated that there are approximately 34,000 groups in the world which claim to be Christians. Some would wear other names, though. One may call himself a Calvinist, or a Lutheran, or any other name which can be imagined; however, we must ask, is this the plan God had for His people? When we examine the book of First Corinthians, we find that the brethren in Corinth had issues with division. Some were claiming to be followers of Paul, some of Peter, and some of Christ (1 Cor. 1:12). The brethren were rebuked by Paul by inspiration in the subsequent verse. "Is Christ divided? was Paul crucified for you? or were ye baptized in the name of Paul?" (1 Cor. 1:13). What was the source of the problem? They were building their faiths on men, rather

than on Christ. We are given one foundation upon which to build. "For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ." (1 Cor. 3:11). Any foundation that any man has laid cannot stand up to Christ. In the words of the Bible, we have all things that pertain to life and godliness (2 Pet. 1:3), so why would anyone want to add anything? When we deviate from the commands of Christ, we deviate from His plan. When we deviate from His plan, we are not part of His body. When we are not part of His body, we are lost. Let us learn the danger of division from the Corinthians, and see that there is only one proper Foundation upon which to build.




