TWO WHOMS

By: Alan Adams

Through whom we received grace and apostleship, unto obedience of faith among all the nations, for his name's sake; among whom are ye also, called to be Jesus Christ's. (Romans 1:5-6)

There are two whoms in this passage. The first is singular and masculine and refers to "Jesus Christ our Lord" (4). The second is plural and neuter and refers to "the nations" (5).

"Through [Jesus Christ our Lord]," Paul says, "We received grace and apostleship unto obedience of faith among all the nations." "To preach the gospel" (1:15) was an apostle's work. The apostles preached, and by the gospel people in the nations were "called" "unto obedience of faith." Some obeyed; thus, "among [the nations]," and particularly so at Rome, were called people. God called them by the gospel; they believed the gospel; and they obeyed the gospel. It is an unvarying pattern.

"The called" is one of a number of New Testament designations for Christians collectively. Among the nations were, are, God's "called," Christians; and then there is everybody else. God's called ones are not people who "call" themselves, or who decide for themselves how and when God calls them. He calls them through the gospel; they hear, believe and obey the gospel. Only at that point are they *the called*.

In other words, within, yet out of, this class of all nations, there is a smaller class with marks or features which set it apart from the rest: the called. Come to think of it, that is precisely the meaning of the word "church," ekklesia: An assembly or group of people within the larger group of all men, yet distinct from it; consequently, a group of people who "live soberly and righteously and godly in this present world" (Titus 2:12), but are distinct from it (cf. 1 Corinthians 5:10; Romans 12:2).

Whom? One is either in the world, among whom are the called; or he is one whom the Lord, by the gospel has called out of the world. W-h-o-m. Short and simple.


