THAT CHURCH

Demetrius called them together. They were shouting and carrying on. Word spread, and soon the whole city was stirred up and rushed into the theater with one accord. That church was in confusion; some shouted one thing and some another. Most of them did not even know why they were there; but they shouted in unison for about two hours. The city clerk finally stood up and quieted the crowd. He said, "You need to calm down, and do things in a lawful church. We could be questioned about today's uproar, and we would have no reason to explain this disorderly gathering" (Acts 19:23-40).

Several things stand out about that church. It was a big church: The whole city was there. It was an excited church: People in attendance were shouting. It was a confused church: Some were shouting one thing, and some another. It was an ignorant church: Most of those present didn't know why they were there. It was a united church: The people shouted in unison. It was a dedicated church: They were totally into what they were doing for about two hours. It was a loud church: The city clerk told them to calm down. It was, according to the city clerk, an unlawful church, and disorderly gathering.

Reading Acts 19:23-40 in our English Bible, we see that the passage doesn't have the word church, it says, assembly. — The "assembly was confused" (Acts 19:32); and the clerk said matters would be determined in a "lawful assembly" (39). But, if we all read Greek, we would notice that the word, assembly, is from the word ekkleisia. That is the word Jesus used when He said, "I will build my church." Reading the Book of Acts, we find "the church" referred to sixteen times; such as: "the Lord added to the church" (2:47); they "gathered the church together" (14:27); elders are to "feed the church of God" (20:28); and so on.

For the sake of irony and elucidation, we supply the word, church, in the passage above. It is useful to compare, distinguish, and discuss that "church" in Ephesus and the "churches of Christ" (Romans 16:16).




