YEOVIL MARSH LOOP

A 3.5 mile loop including muddy terrain, stiles and bridges

This walk starts at the Draycott end of the Hook Drove, so if you're driving you'll want to park there.

The beginning of the walk is straight forward; follow the Drove over the hill, past the woodland and all the way to the small metal gate. Simply follow the blue 'Public Bridleway' signage, continuing past the larger metal gate and down the track until you meet a junction. Again, follow the bridleway signage through the wooden gate and onto a narrower, shady track with trees either side.

You should eventually come to a large concrete platform with a small pool of water either side. Cross the platform, and immediately after go through the two metal gates you can see on the right. At a 90° angle to the Drove, cross the field and head towards the stile. Once over the stile, turn to the right, and head for the next stile in the corner of the field. Go over this, along with the bridge at the bottom of the subsequent field. Next, head up the side of the field towards a rusty gate, and, once you're through it, head up the right hand side of the field. You should find a stile hidden away in the corner amongst a hedge. Clamber over this before heading across the field to the right hand corner. You'll find yourself back on the drove; head back up it and you've finished!
