Project Linus Quilts

In November, we will start working on our Project Linus quilts. These quilts go to children in need, to comfort them during their experience. Some of them are dealing with a medical issue and some of them are experiencing an emotional issue. They are given to children from birth to 18 years old. The quilt can be any design. It must be made of new material that is free from any smells. There is no particular size requirement. We determine the size according to the age of the child who would be receiving the quilt. If it is for a baby or young child, we usually make them about 40" x 50". If it is for a teenager, we usually make them about 50" x 65". You can use your own judgment on the size. We want them to be big enough so that the child can comfortably cover up with it.

I do have patterns, ideas and material that you are welcome to use. Just let me know if you need anything.

We no longer have access to the kitchen, so if you are coming, please bring a lunch and drink for yourself.

If you wish to sew on Community Service items at home, contact me and we can make arrangements. If you turn in any items on your own, that we are making for Community Service, please let me know so I can include them in my count. Even though our group concentrates on specific projects at the meetings, you may work on any project any time during the year.
