Kindness Caps

I have adapted the pattern from Vanessa Wilson's pattern at Crafty Gemini.com.

Material: fleece or cotton knit

Cut out 4 pieces for the cap, making sure that the stretch of the material is going across the pattern.

Using a 3/8" seam, sew together two of the pieces along the curved edge, right sides together. Repeat for the other two pieces. Then sew those pieces together, right sides facing and matching center seams. For the knit cap turn up 2 inches for the hem and zigzag the edge. For the fleece, turn up a 4 inches for the hem and zigzag the edge. Turn up the cuff.

Since the people wearing these caps have lost their hair, the caps cannot be serged. The serging irates their sensitive heads.
