



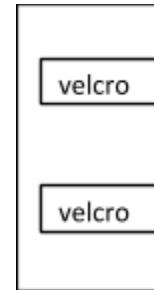
Port Pillow Directions

Material

Two 7" x 4" pieces of flannel or quilted material

Two 3" pieces of 5/8" wide Velcro

Fiberfill stuffing



Sew scant 3/8" seams. Round one end of each piece of Velcro. Baste the loop piece of the Velcro to the long side of the right side of one piece of fabric, positioning them about 1 1/2" from the top and bottom of the fabric, having the ends even with the edge of the fabric. Sew across the end of the Velcro. This piece will face up.

Baste the hook side of the Velcro on the opposite side of that piece of fabric. This piece should face down. These two pieces will overlap.

Pin the two rectangle pieces of fabric together right sides facing and sew three sides, leaving one short side open for stuffing. Turn inside out and stuff a little loosely. Sew the bottom closed either by machine or hand.
