

### **SYNOPSIS**

## EBONÉ A Play in Five Acts

What happens after we leave this physical world? And what is **that** experience based on?

Do we return to pure consciousness? Do we continue to evolve?

Are we creating our own experience here as well as there?

#### - Unknown

Anger and resentment poison the soul. Left unresolved...they can trap the soul for eternity. Pure forgiveness may be the antidote to set it free.

#### - Unknown

It's 1809 in Paris, France. Eboné Dubois witnesses the violent murder of her father Pier Dubois on a stormy evening after they return home from the reading of the Last Will and Testament of François Dubois, a kind, gifted and successful composer who had succumbed to an illness after a short battle. François was a dear and loving uncle to Eboné and the youngest of the three Dubois brothers. Over the last few weeks, his declining health has become the main cause of concern for the family. However, only one concern dominates the mind of the middle brother, Nicolas Dubois. That concern is who is to serve as Executor of François' Estate. Nicolas Dubois, greedy and selfish, will stop at nothing to take control for himself. His evil nature has always been very palpable for Eboné but others never seem to notice.

Pier is the only person François trusted as his Executor. Nicolas' decision to kill his eldest brother Pier creates a deep wound within Eboné and sends ripples of despair through generations of the Dubois family...beyond many dimensions.

Eboné's soul, after witnessing the death of her beloved father at the hands of her uncle Nicolas, is singed with the **need** for revenge and redemption so much so that, after her death one year after her parent's murders, she remains trapped between worlds, unable to move forward.

Trapped between lives, she expends her energy chasing Nicolas' essence into the lives of the Dubois descendants...into the 1990s...into America, causing devastation and mass unrest.

Only after agreeing to let go and to forgive, does Eboné move on and all are able to carry on. "...come receive the peace that is yours."
