- Last 7-Year MVR
- Provide Training Dates
- Complete RSN Instructor Shadow Training (6-20 hours)
- Activate Payroll Account
- Activate Instructor Portal
- Sign Direct Deposit Form
- Sign Instructor Contract
- Submit 1099
- Activate Communication Software
- Receive Training Gear and Training Car
- Start Training on Your own!

This is where instructors will accompany thier students to take the state road test exam at the local testing center

Instructor Training

Each instructor is required to obtain an instructor's certification with the Roadway Safety Network. Certificates are received when on the road training is successfully completed.

Schedule 6 - 12 hours of instructor shadow training.

- A certified Roadway Safety Network trainer will come out and conduct you're on the road training.
- This training is performed on the road and in local parking lots.
- The trainer will train in a student driver training vehicle
- Please wear comfortable clothing and bring a bottle of water.
- Some of your training will involve active students learning to drive.
