Prepare Your Vehicle Before You Travel:

- Check tire pressure & tread
- Top off all fluids (oil, coolant, washer fluid)
- Confirm headlights, brake lights, and signals are working
- Clean snow/ice off windows before driving

Slow Down & Increase Following Distance

Holiday traffic, colder temperatures, and wet roads increase stopping distances. Give yourself extra space.

Avoid Distractions

Put phones on "Do Not Disturb While Driving," especially with children or holiday excitement in the car.

Plan Your Route Early

Use navigation with real-time traffic updates. Avoid unfamiliar shortcuts in bad weather or at night.

Stay Alert & Rested

If you feel tired, pull over. Many winter accidents occur due to fatigue.
