ENTRY FORMS

****Mailed entries postmarked by 6/13/26 receive a \$10 discount per horse! Thank you for helping our show secretary ****

All entries after this date must be delivered in person to the show.

All entries must be made in writing on an official entry form for this show. Include the name, address, and signature of the registered horse owner and the agent or trainer (sign both lines if trainer is also the owner). Payment by check, credit card, or open check should accompany entry form. Copies of all required documentation of ownership and eligibility to show must accompany the entry form. A \$10 fee will be charged for any incomplete entry form. Exhibitors are responsible for any error on an entry form. Exhibitor packets and back numbers will not be released until all entries are complete.

TO BE ANNOUNCED (TBA) CLASSES

To add a TBA class, the requesting exhibitor entrant must pay a fee of \$30 in addition to the class entry fee. The \$30 fee will be waived or refunded if at least 3 additional exhibitors also enter the class. TBA Classes will be accepted on a first come- first served basis and are not guaranteed. Please submit your TBA request to the Show Secretary prior to the show. Any class on the [AHA Class List](#) or recognized by AHA may be added except dressage, sport horse, cutting, working hunter, reined cow, and working cow.

STALLS

Stalls MUST be reserved by Wednesday, 6/24/2026. If you have not submitted entries including stalls, you must contact the show manager Pamm Payne directly to reserve stalls.

Stall assignment will be sent out on Thursday, 6/25/26. Stalls are permanent box stalls with doors. Payment in full must accompany stall reservations. Telephone stall requests are not guaranteed. Stall fees are not refundable, whether used or not.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Copies of the following must be submitted at the time of entry:

HORSE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE (front and back) *for A/HA classes only*

- A horse must be entered in the name of the registered owner(s) only.
- If owner is an entity (farm/ranch/corporation, etc), the horse may be shown in AOTR/JOTR classes if the exhibitor's family is the sole owner of the farm/entity.
- Sale of a horse does not eliminate this requirement. "Contracts of Sale" or "Bill of Sale" will not be accepted.

AHA MEMBERSHIP AND COMPETITION CARD *for A/HA classes only*

- If you are not a current AHA Competition member, you must pay a \$40 Single Event Membership fee or purchase an annual membership and card.

For AHA non-members the AHA Single Event Member Fee @\$40.00 needs to be paid directly to AHA online before the show starts.

- An exhibitor in Amateur/Junior Owner classes must be the registered owner or a family member of the registered owner of the horse they are showing.
- For a horse owned by an entity (including but not limited to: a corporation, farm/ranch, trust, syndicate, partnership, or estate) a copy of the AHA Business Membership must be presented, or a Single Event Membership Fee of \$40.00/person will be charged.

OPEN BREED CLASSES DO NOT REQUIRE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE OR AHA MEMBERSHIP AND COMPETITION CARD

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT *FOR AHA CLASSES ONLY*

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR.

For AHA non-members the AHA Single Event Member Fee @\$40.00 needs to be paid directly to AHA online before the show starts.

WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP.

SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

USEF MEMBERSHIP

USEF membership is not required to participate in an AHA Value Show. However, to compete in any Amateur class, you must be in compliance with USEF rules governing amateur status (see USEF Rulebook, AR 110.6 & AR 110.7). Your signature on the back of the entry form affirms that by participating in an Amateur class, you are in compliance with USEF Amateur rules. Check "Yes" in the Amateur Status field of the entry form if you provide a copy of your USEF Amateur Member card. Otherwise check "No."

CROSS ENTRIES

AHA/USEF Rules apply to cross entries for Arabian rated classes. For all open breed classes: Exhibitors MAY NOT cross enter between walk/trot and walk/trot canter classes. Exhibitors MAY NOT cross enter between Academy and any other class. Horses may cross enter if handled/ridden by different exhibitors.

AMATEUR/JUNIOR OWNER CLASSES

For Amateur/Junior Owner classes (AOTR/D/H, JOTR/D/H, AOTS), the exhibitor or a member of the exhibitor's family must be the horse's registered owner, as defined in [USEF AR110.4](#). Horses registered in a farm/syndicate/partnership/corporation or other entity name may be shown in owner classes if the exhibitor's family is the sole owner of the farm or entity as defined in [USEF AR110.4.d.e.f](#). The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted in Owner classes.) Competitor must be an amateur/junior exhibitor AND a recorded owner of the horse or a family member of the recorded owner(s).

Family members include: spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, brother, sister, half brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, step-brother and sister, grandparents and grandchildren and in-laws of the same relation as stated above. Combined ownership is permitted in Owner's or Amateur Owner's classes. Refer to [USEF AR110.4.e.1-11](#).

Owner classes may be restricted to riders, drivers or handlers who are no longer eligible to compete as a junior exhibitor.

OWNERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Ownership of any entered horse must be clearly stated on the entry form. Any deviation between registration papers and entry form must be supported by contract, etc. A copy of proof of ownership must be included with entry form.

SIGNATURES

Entries will not be accepted without required signatures. Signature by a parent/guardian is required if the exhibitor is a minor. Minors are not allowed to sign as either owner or trainer.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRY

CLASS ENTRY FEES will be refunded for horses withdrawn from entry ONLY if excused by Show Management in writing. Entry may be withdrawn prior to June 13, 2026. Refund will be issued upon presentation of a signed and dated veterinarian's certificate, delivered in person or mailed to the Show Secretary on or before the end of the last class of the show. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL STALL OR OFFICE FEES BE REFUNDED.

SUBSTITUTION OF SHOW STAFF MEMBERS

In the event of illness or failure of a Staff Member to attend the show or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute another Staff Member in his/her place.

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSE

All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Greater Kansas City Arabian Horse Association, nor the Longview Horse Park will be responsible for loss, personal injury or damage to horses exhibited; or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or in any way damaged. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person, or any animal, or damage of any property while on the show grounds by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her; and shall indemnify the Management against all legally established claims or damage of any kind or nature that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her, or arise from negligence of the person in charge of any such horse. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance of each person that signed same of the provisions herein set forth.

GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION

This horse show is conducted in accordance with the rules of AHA. Judging, class specifications, rules and conduct shall be in accordance with the current [USEF Rulebook, Arabian Horse Division](#).

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE TIME

Stall assignment will be sent out on Thursday, 6/25/26. Stalls will be available the night before the show. The show grounds will be open at 4:00 pm on Friday, 6/26/26 for check-ins. The show office will be open from 4:00-8:00 pm on Friday, 6/26/26 for check ins and post entries. Do not stall a horse unless stall has been assigned. Horses must be removed from the show grounds after the conclusion of the show.

BEDDING/SHAVINGS

No bedding will be furnished with stalls. Shavings will be available for purchase. Straw will not be available for purchase.

STALLS

Stalls MUST be reserved by Wednesday, 6/24/26. Stall assignment will be sent out on Thursday, 6/25/26. Stall assignments will NOT be changed after assignments are posted. Extra stalls will not be available on the day of the show. Stalls are permanent box stalls with doors. Payment in full must accompany stall reservations. Telephone stall requests are not guaranteed. Stall fees are not refundable, whether used or not.

ARENA

All classes are held in outdoor arenas (sand footing). Sport horse in-hand (if offered) will be held using regulation triangle. All other classes are held in a non-regulation standard riding arena. All arenas must be vacated while facility equipment is being used. Schedule for schooling will be posted at the show grounds.

SHARPS CONTAINERS

Sharps containers for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments (1 container for every 50 occupied stalls) will be placed in

convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. These containers when full will be disposed of properly. Competition management may fine any individual (including trainer, owner, exhibitor, or agent) up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

INSURANCE ADVISORY

Due to the number and quality of horses at this show, we urge each exhibitor to verify their liability insurance and livestock mortality coverages are in effect. The Greater Kansas City Arabian Horse Association, its members, agents, employees, and volunteers accept no responsibility for losses sustained or caused by any exhibitor.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

No motorized or other vehicle (scooter, golf cart, etc.) is allowed in the arena, paddock, or schooling areas unless operated by a show official. When operating vehicles in other areas, please adhere to safety rules and be considerate of horses, exhibitors, and spectators.

PARKING

Park only in designated areas. Parking any vehicle or trailer in illegal areas or fire lanes will result in the vehicle being towed at the owner's expense.

DOGS

Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. No dog will be allowed in the Show Arena at any time.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Longview Horse Park has excellent drainage in the warm up and show arenas, with low likelihood that muddy footing will cancel the show. If necessary, rain delays will be announced. All attempts will be made to continue the show. If the show cannot be held due to extensive periods of heavy rain or other extenuating circumstances, the show will be rescheduled for another weekend in the summer based on availability of Longview Horse Park. Show fees and entries will be automatically transferred to the new date.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

These Rules and Regulations are established for the fair, equitable and efficient management of this show in compliance with [AHA Value Show Rules and Guidelines](#). The GKCAHA Longview AVS Show is approved by AHA as a Value Show. The Show Management reserves the right to make changes in procedure, personnel, rules and regulations not governed by AHA as determined by them to be in the best interest of the show.

ADMISSION TO ARENA

No person will be admitted to the arena except participants in the class, judges and their assistants, official show personnel, and the show photographer and his or her assistant. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena until summoned by order of the Judge.

AGE OF RIDER

The age of a rider is determined as of December 1st of each year and maintained until December 1st of the following year.

COMMUNICATION DEVICES

Use of any electronic/radio communication devices is prohibited in the show arena.

CRUELTY

CRUELTY TO OR THE ABUSE OF A HORSE BY ANY PERSON AT A RECOGNIZED SHOW IS FORBIDDEN. PENALTY FOR CRUELTY WILL BE ENFORCED TO THE FULL EXTENT OF THE RULES AND LAW. Such actions could include, but are not limited to, excessive use of whips or spurs.

DISCOURTESY/DISOBEDIENCE

Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to show officials by the owner, groom, rider, driver, or handler will disqualify the horse for further adjudication. Show management reserves the right to remove a groom, horse, rider, driver, or handler from the show without liability for compensation or damages. It is a violation of AHA Rules to commit any act or make any remark during the show that is considered offensive or intended to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. Show management reserves the right to bar an exhibitor from the show for these offenses.

DISQUALIFICATION

All horses doctored in any way, artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the show ring will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made, or caused to be made, any false statement regarding any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, the exhibitor shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. If any horse is disqualified after being awarded a prize in a class, the winner of the next succeeding prize in the class shall claim the prize previously awarded to the disqualified horse.

HEALTH CERTIFICATE (INTERSTATE) AND COGGINS TEST —You Must Have A Copy

The State of Missouri requires a [valid health certificate](#) for every horse from another state entering Missouri. Any horse six months and older entering Missouri from another state shall be accompanied by an official health certificate from the state of origin, proclaiming the animal to be free from symptoms of any infectious disease or exposure thereto. Health certificate must be issued by a state, federal, or licensed accredited veterinarian stating that examination was made within thirty (30) days prior to start of the horse show.

The State of Missouri also requires proof of a negative Coggins test on ANY HORSE exhibited in the state. Coggins Test Certificate must be dated within twelve (12) months prior to the date of show. Vaccination records are required, dated within six (6) months prior to the date of show. Do not submit your Coggins Test Certificate and vaccination records with your entry form. Keep these items in your possession and present them at check-in. Show management reserves the right to randomly check health papers.

JUDGES

It is a violation of AHA rules to commit any act or make any remark during the show that is considered offensive or intended to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. Exhibitors shall not have contact with a show judge, or approach a judge regarding a decision, unless accompanied by a member of Show Management. If any judge or other show official designated in this prize list is unable to perform their duties, Show Management reserves the right to substitute the individual according to USEF rules.

PROTESTS

Any protest must be made in accordance with the [AHA Code of Ethics and Sportsmanship](#) (see ETHICS 108).

SHOEING REGULATIONS

Refer to the 2024 [AHA Value Show Rules & Regulations](#) (see SHOW 120).

VETERINARIAN INSPECTIONS

At the discretion of Show Management, all horses are subject to inspection by the show veterinarian for the use of mydriatic drugs, or if suspected not to be serviceably sound. All decisions of the show veterinarian shall be final and may not be contradicted by another veterinarian used by the exhibitor (also see Health Certifications under RULES & REGULATIONS).

WHIPS

Each handler may use only one whip (not to exceed 6' in length including snapper/lash/appendage) inside or outside the ring while showing a horse. A small appendage (ribbon, plastic, etc. less than 12 inches long) is permitted. Harness classes are excepted. Excessive or improper use of a whip shall be cause for disqualification.

AHA ENTRY AGREEMENT

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association® (AHA®) Handbook and the Value Show Rules and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules **and understand all decisions made by the judge are deemed final and cannot be protested.**

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION. This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, leasee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of a minor Participant) to waive all claims that may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to **release** AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and **all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent** permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition **INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES**, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

I AGREE to **indemnify and hold harmless** (that is pay all losses, damages, attorneys fees and costs of) the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, demands, penalties, actions, losses, costs, damages, injuries, liabilities and obligations (including attorney's fees) of whatsoever kind and nature, which may be asserted against or incurred by any of them as a result of (1) my participation in the Competition or (2) any act, failure to act, or neglect (a) by me, my agents, employees, riders, handlers, trainers, coaches, drivers, contractors or invitees, or (b) by any animal owned or exhibited by me or in my custody or control.

I AGREE to accept AS FINAL any decision of AHA, the Show Commission or Show Officials concerning my qualification or the qualification of my horse to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition, except to the extent that the Rules of AHA, the Competition, Equestrian Canada or U.S. Equestrian Federation permit a protest or hearing of such decisions. Should a hearing be requested, **I agree to accept AS FINAL** the decision of the particular hearing body. **I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue** AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s)' qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

I AGREE and represent that I am qualified and eligible to enter and/or participate in the Competition and every horse I am entering is qualified and eligible as entered. **I FURTHER AGREE that by participating in an Amateur class that I am in compliance with the USEF Amateur rule.**

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain in effect.

Under Missouri law, an equine professional or activity sponsor is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities pursuant to the Revised Statutes of Missouri, RSMO 537.325. **Under Kansas law**, there is no liability for an injury to or the death of a participant in domestic animal activities resulting from the inherent risks of domestic animal activities, pursuant to K.S.A. 60-4001 through 60-4004. You are assuming the risk of participating in this domestic animal activity.

I/We, the Undersigned, have read and do understand the foregoing agreement, warnings, release, and assumption of risk. I/We verify that I/We voluntarily and knowingly make these releases. I understand and agree that by entering this competition, I am subject to the rules of the competition and the prize list.
