ENTRIES CLOSE APRIL 15, 2022

POST ENTRY FEE

Post entries will be accepted. There is a one-time post entry fee charge per horse of **\$25.00 for any horses entered after April 15, 2022.**

EARLY ARRIVALS

If you plan on arriving early (Before April 21, 2022 at 9 a.m.) you must contact the co-show managers Jim Wray, 918-237-5289 and Mike Grimm, 617-429-1732, or barn manager Glen True, 816-223-7496 to make arrangements. There will be a \$20 per day charge per stall used for early arrivals.

ENTRY FORMS

Entry forms must be filled out completely. Trainers must sign with their signature and give their address. If owner is the trainer, sign in both places.

All entries for morning classes must be made by 8 p.m. the night before. No entries will be taken after 8 p.m. unless otherwise posted. Sunday post entries must be made no later than one hour before each session. **NOTE :**The Show bank account will close 60 days after the show.

LOCATION

The show office is located in the southwest corner of the Coliseum, which is the building with the main ring.

ENTRY INFORMATION

NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN CLASSES

All classes will be held, with awards and ribbons presented according to placings. Classes may be split or combined as deemed necessary by the show committee.

POST ENTRIES

There will be a flat charge of \$25.00 per horse entered after the deadline. All entries postmarked after April 15, 2022, will be charged a post entry fee. Horses entered in the show on or before the deadline will be exempt from this penalty for additional classes entered after the deadline.

ENTRIES CLOSE APRIL 15, 2022

Entries postmarked after this date will be charged post entry fees. Do not mail entries after April 16. Entries must be accompanied by full payment in order to be processed. All incomplete entries will be charged \$10. (See Fee and Entry Information, page 7).

Entries must be properly made on the official entry form in the name of the legal owner only, giving the legal owners' complete address and social security or federal tax ID number. They must be signed in all places by the exhibitor, agent and/or trainer and accompanied by the required copies of registration and membership cards.

Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and those of their agents in the preparation of entry blanks. Packets/ Exhibitor numbers will not be released until all entries are completed.

There will be a \$50.00 charge for all checks returned by the bank for any reason. Returned checks not paid within two weeks after notification will be turned over to US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION.

REQUIRED PHOTOCOPIES

Checklist of items to be sent with entries

- Both sides of horse registration papers.
- AHA membership competition cards (owner, trainer, rider, driver, handler). If horses are registered in farm name, must have farm/ranch membership or **SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEES must be charged** at \$35.00 per person.

AMATEUR & AOTR CLASSES

All riders 19 years or older in AOTR or Amateur classes must have in their possession Amateur Certification issued by US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION or make application for such certification at least one hour prior to showing in these classes. Only active USEF members may obtain amateur certification. Applications may be secured from the Show Secretary. Exhibitors may sign affidavits verifying their US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION amateur application.

Refer to GR 1306 & GR1307 for Amateur Status.

Amateur Owner Classes

- A. Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by AR110.4.d.e.f (Horses registered in a farm/ranch/syndicate/partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity as defined by AR110.4.d.e.f. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted in Owner classes.)
- B. Every competitor must be an amateur and the owner, or an amateur member of the owner's family.
- C. Owner's classes may be restricted to riders, drivers or handlers who are no longer eligible to compete as a junior exhibitor.
- D. For ownership by the same family, the term family includes the following: spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, brother, sister, half brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, step-brother and sister, grandparents and grandchildren and in-laws of the same relation as stated above.
- E. Combined ownership is permitted in Owner's or Amateur Owner's classes. As per GR142.4 combined ownership is permitted in Junior Owner's or Amateur Owner's classes under the following conditions: Please refer to AR110.4.e.1-11 for conditions.

AHA MEMBER & NON-MEMBER FEES

Any owner, trainer, driver, rider, or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring must have an AHA membership competition card or pay a SINGLE EVENT FEE of \$35.00. If papers are in the name of a farm, owner must have a Farm/Ranch AHA membership.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR.

WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP.

SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

ENTRY INFORMATION

SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

SIGNATURES

Entries will not be accepted without required signatures. Juniors are not allowed to sign as either owner or trainer.

SHOW TABS

Any exhibitor wishing to start a tab at the show office will be required to leave a signed check made payable to "MO-KAN Border Bonanza" so that the check will be completed by the show office for the amount due at the close of the show. You should check out at the earliest possible time, toward the close of the show to avoid delays.

TO BE ANNOUNCED CLASSES

To officially have a class added in a TO BE ANNOUNCED Class slot, a fee of \$70.00 must be paid by at least one entrant. If the \$70 fee is paid to add a class listed as a To Be Announced class, it will be added to the class list.

If there is a TBA class that you want to have added, we recommend you contact the Show Secretary prior to the show. If the class has 5 or more entries, the \$70.00 fee will be waived.

Any class on the AHA Class List or that is recognized by AHA may be added, **except** dressage, sport horse, cutting, working hunter, reined cow, and working cow.

SPONSORSHIPS

Regular Class Sponsorship is \$25.00 per class. A Championship Class Sponsorship is \$50.00 per Class.

WARM-UP PADDOCK: PLEASE TAKE NOTE

Only horses and exhibitors for the next two classes will be allowed in the warm-up paddock. This will be enforced.

- AHA medal classes: medal to winner

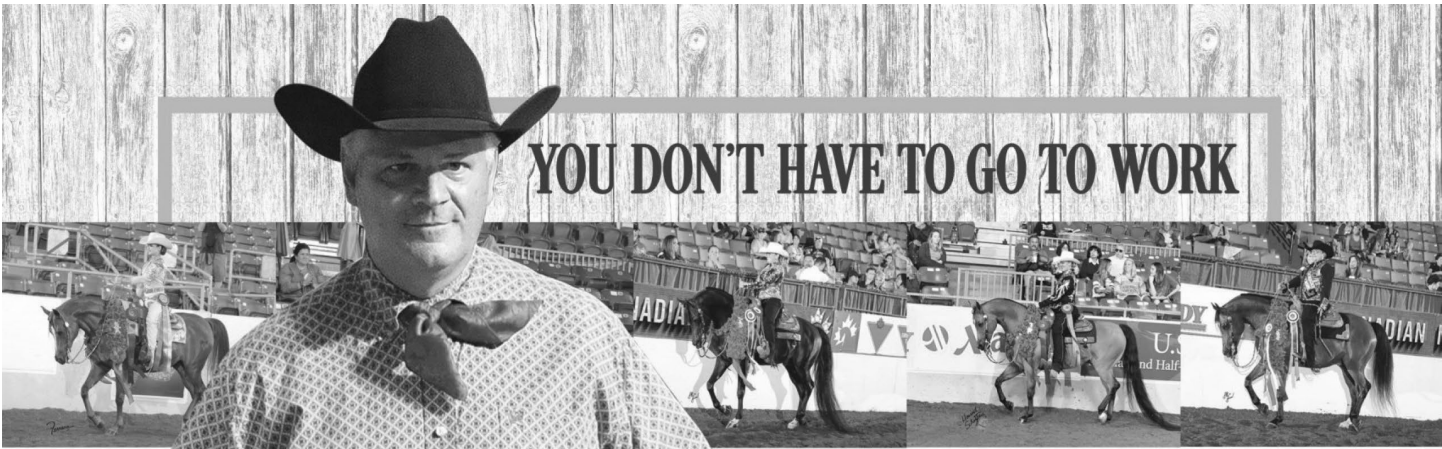

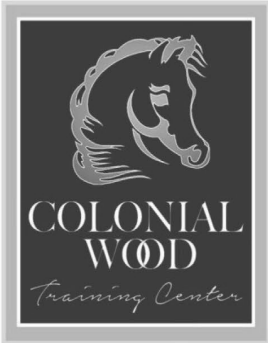

GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION

The Eastern Kansas and Greater Kansas City Arabian Horse Associations welcome you to the MO-KAN Border Bonanza AVS, a concurrently judged Region 8 and 11 qualifying show at the Missouri State Fairgrounds in Sedalia, Missouri.

A NOTE ABOUT CONCURRENT JUDGING

This system allows us to hold concurrently adjudicated classes at the same time/date in a single arena with identical AHA class codes, using two different judges for each class.

- All classes at the 2022 Border Bonanza will be concurrent, with one judge's results qualifying for region 8 and the other's qualifying for region 11.
- Exhibitors in concurrently run classes will always be judged by both judges.
- Please allow more time per class due to the fact that it will take extra time to present the placings and awards for both judges.

ARRIVAL TIME

Stalls will be available Thursday, April 21, 2022 at 9:00 AM. IF EARLIER ARRIVAL IS NEEDED, PLEASE CONTACT THE BARN MANAGER OR CO-SHOW MANAGER(S) TO MAKE SPECIFIC ARRANGEMENTS. THERE WILL BE A \$20.00 PER DAY CHARGE PER STALL USED FOR EARLY ARRIVALS. Barn Manager will post stall assignment chart in show office, showing stall and aisle numbers. Do not stall a horse unless stall has been assigned.

BEDDING/SHAVINGS

No bedding will be furnished with stalls. Bedding will be available for purchase. Straw will not be available for purchase. **ALL BEDDING MUST BE PURCHASED FROM THE MISSOURI FAIR GROUNDS AND PAID THROUGH THE SHOW OFFICE.**

CAMPER HOOK-UPS

The Missouri State Fairgrounds facilities provide travelers with outstanding campsite opportunities year-round. The

campgrounds are open 24-hours every day, so you are welcome to pull in to the Public, Overnight Camping area day or night. All types of camping units, including tents, are easily accommodated.

- Site with all utilities, as available, \$35.00/night (water, electricity (30-amps), and sewer)
- Site without utilities \$12.00/night.

DEPARTURE TIME

Horses must be removed from the show grounds by 10:00 AM, Monday, April 25, 2022 unless specific arrangements have been made with the show manager. Additional fees for late departure may be required.

DOGS

All dogs must be confined to a leash at all times. No dogs will be allowed in the Show Arena at any time.

FOOTING

Coliseum - 174' x 118' dirt, sand, sawdust, arena floor, 2,360 seats, overhead fans, with adjacent warm-up ring.

- Please, no lunging in the Coliseum (the main show ring) once the show begins.
- Entry for the classes will be through the north entry from the MFA Youth Area and exit through the west door. All Driving and Halter Classes will enter and exit by the west door.

MFA Youth Livestock Arena - 80' x 220' dirt/sand floor, metal roof with covered entryway to Coliseum, overhead fans and lighting.

Donnelly Arena - 160' x 60' earth floor with some sand, metal roof, overhead fans, utilities available.

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSE

All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither the Eastern Kansas Arabian Horse Association, the Greater Kansas City Arabian Horse Association, or the Missouri State Fairgrounds will be responsible for loss, personal injury or damage to horses exhibited; or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or in any way damaged. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person, or any animal, or damage of any property while on the show grounds by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her; and shall indemnify the Management against all legally established claims or damage of any kind or nature that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horse

owned or exhibited by him/her, or arise from negligence of the person in charge of any such horse. The submitting of an entry form to the show secretary shall constitute an acceptance of each person that signed same of the provisions herein set forth.

Paddock

Only horses and exhibitors for the next two classes will be allowed in the warm-up paddock. This will be enforced.

Parking

Parking is available in designated areas only. Parking of any vehicle or trailer in illegal areas or fire lanes will result in the vehicle being towed at the owner's expense.

SECURITY

Exhibitors are advised that it is their responsibility to secure their valuables and stall area.

STAFF MEMBERS

In the event that due to illness or failure of a Staff Member to attend the show or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute another Staff Member in his/her place.

RULES & REGULATIONS

These Rules and Regulations are established for the fair, equitable and efficient management of this show, complying with requirements of AHA Value Show, which approve this show. The show management reserves the right to make changes in procedure, personnel, rules and regulations not governed by AHA Value Show as determined by them to be in the best interest of the show.

ADMISSION TO ARENA

No person will be admitted to the arena except participants in the class, judges and their assistants, official show personnel, and the show photographer and his or her assistant. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena until summoned by order of the Judge.

AGE OF RIDER

The age of the rider shall be determined as of December 1st of each year and shall be maintained until December 1st of the following year.

CANCELLATION OR COMBINATION OF CLASSES

The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel a class or to combine or split classes as they deem necessary, due to numbers of entries in the class. In the event that a class is not available, entry fees will be refunded.

CLASS CALLS

Classes will be called promptly. Two minutes will be allowed after the first horse in the class enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. Exhibitors are requested to come to the warm-up ring 15 minutes prior to class. Tack changes must be reported to the Paddock Manager at least two classes ahead to permit proper notification to ring officials. A maximum three-minute hold will be allowed. Exhibitor requesting hold must notify gate promptly when tack change has been completed so class can enter ring without any unnecessary delay. All tack changes must be made in the paddock area. Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the public address system must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every reasonable effort will be made to maintain a working public address system to carry class calls.

COMMUNICATION DEVICES

Use of any electronic/radio communication devices is prohibited in the show arena.

CRUELTY

CRUELTY TO OR THE ABUSE OF A HORSE BY ANY PERSON AT A RECOGNIZED SHOW IS FORBIDDEN AND PENALTY FOR SAME WILL BE ENFORCED TO THE FULL EXTENT OF THE RULES AND LAW. Such actions could include, but are not limited to excessive use of whip or spurs.

DISCIPLINE

Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider, driver, or handler will disqualify the horse for further adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a groom, horse, rider, driver, or handler from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. It is a violation of AHA Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging, and any exhibitor may be barred from the show for this offense by the show committee.

DISQUALIFICATION

All horses doctored in any way, artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the show ring will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made, or caused to be made, any false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. In case of any animal being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in the class shall take the prize that has been awarded to such disqualified animal.

MISSOURI STATE FAIR GROUNDS RULES

Will be posted in the show office. By signing your entry form, all owners, drivers, riders, handlers and grooms agree to adhere to these rules.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES-YOU MUST HAVE A COPY

The State of Missouri requires a valid health certificate for each and every horse. All horses six months and older entering the Missouri State Fair Grounds shall be accompanied by an official health certificate of state of origin issued by a state, federal or licensed accredited veterinarian and such certificate shall include a veterinarian's statement that examination was made within the past thirty (30) days and revealed the animal to be free from symp-

toms of any infectious disease or exposure thereto. It is against the law to exhibit a horse in Missouri without a negative Coggins test, dated within twelve (12) months of the showing date. Vaccination records within 6 months of date of show are required. Do not submit your Coggins Test Certificate with your entries. Keep the certificate in your possession until such time as it is requested. No horse will be assigned a stall without first showing proof of a negative Coggins test. Show management reserves the right to randomly check health papers.

AHA JUDGES COMMISSIONER/RESULTS RECORDING FEE

All exhibitors must pay a fee of \$10.00 per horse for the Education/ Evaluation Fund + an \$10.00 results recording fee. (\$20.00 per horse total)

INSURANCE ADVISORY

Due to the number and quality of horses at this show, we urge each exhibitor to verify their liability insurance coverage, and their livestock mortality coverage with their own insurance carrier(s). Be sure your coverages are in effect. The Eastern Kansas Arabian Horse Association, the Greater Kansas City Arabian Horse Association, its members, agents, employees, and volunteers accept no responsibility for losses sustained or caused by any exhibitor.

JUDGES

1) The Show Management reserves the absolute right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in this prize list. 2) It is a violation of AHA rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging.

JUNIOR EXHIBITORS

Juniors eligible for Junior Exhibitor, Showmanship and Equitation classes shall not have reached their 19th birthday as of December 1.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian, or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting

from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

"NO SHOWS"

Exhibitors who fail to officially scratch an entry in the show office prior to the start of the class are subject to a fine of \$10.00.

OWNERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

The ownership of all horses entered in the show must be clearly stated on the entry form. Any deviation between papers and entry must have reason (contract, etc.) and copies of proof of ownership must be included with entries.

PROTESTS

Any protest must be made in accordance with the AHA rules.

SCHOOLING IN THE COLISEUM ARENA

The Coliseum will be open for schooling and warm up all day Thursday and Thursday night and at night upon the conclusion of the show on Friday and Saturday. The MFA Youth Arena and Donnelly Arena will be open all day and night Thursday through Sunday for the schooling and warm up. Please, no lunging in the Coliseum (the main show ring) once the show begins.

SHARPS CONTAINERS

Sharps containers will be placed every fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. These containers when full will be disposed of properly. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainer, owners, exhibitors or their agents up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of

needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

SHOEING REGULATIONS

Refer to AHA Value Show Regulations. See Show 120.

SMOKING

Smoking is NOT permitted in the coliseum or in the barn areas.

STALLIONS

Stallions may be shown by ladies or junior exhibitors in all classes except Junior Showmanship and Walk-Trot. Colts or stallions two years or older must have both testicles descended.

STALLS

EVERY HORSE MUST HAVE A STALL. Payments in full for stall reservations must accompany stall requests. Telephone stall requests will not be guaranteed. **Stall fees are not refundable, whether used or not, will be enforced.** Stalls are permanent box stalls with doors.

VEHICLES

No vehicle of any kind (scooter, golf carts, etc.) will be allowed in the arena, paddock or schooling areas, except when operated by show official personnel. In operating any vehicles, please be aware of safety rules and have consideration for horses, exhibitors and spectators.

VETERINARIAN INSPECTIONS

All animals are subject to a physical inspection and may be examined for the use of mydriatic drugs by the show veterinarian at the discretion of the show management. All horses must be serviceably sound. In the case of suspected unsoundness, the Judge may, if so desired, have the animal examined by the Show Veterinarian, to determine soundness, and the show veterinarian's decision shall be final. No exhibitor may use another veterinarian's statement to contradict the decision of the judge or show veterinarians. Also see Health Certifications under Rules & Regulations.

WHIPS

No item may be used inside or outside the ring while showing a horse, except one whip per handler, to be no longer than 6' including snapper/lash/appendage. Small appendages (no more than 12 inches in length) of ribbon, plastic, etc. are permitted. Harness classes are excepted. Excessive or improper use of a whip shall be a basis for disqualification.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Exhibitors will not receive a refund for scratched horses unless excused by the management in writing. Entries may be scratched from the show prior to April 15, 2022. Refunds for CLASS ENTRY FEES ONLY will be made upon presentation to the show secretary (delivered in person to show office or mailed) a signed and dated veterinarian's certificate on or before the end of the last class of the show. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL STALL OR OFFICE FEES BE REFUNDED.**

This show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the USEF, Arabian Horse Division. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THERE –WITH. Any changes or correction of the rules will automatically become part of this premium list. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. Exhibitors are encouraged to read the USEF Rule book, and particularly the complete Arabian and Half-Arabian Horse rules, class descriptions and judging specifications. The show committee will decide questions not covered by the USEF Rules, and its decision will be final.

Maiden, Novice, and Limit Horse/Rider

Maiden, Novice and Limit classes are open to horses which have not won one/three/six first place ribbons respectively, at Regular Competitions of the Federation or Equestrian Canada in the particular performance division or level in which they are shown. Ribbons won in one-horse classes do not count in reckoning the maiden, novice or limit status of either horses and/or rider/driver in any division. The status of Maiden, Novice and Limit entries is as of the closing date of entries for any particular Licensed Competition. USEF GR136, AR 110 .8-.9.

Walk Trot—Pleasure & Equitation

Riders may not enter any other performance class in this show, except Lead Line, and/or Showmanship. No Pay-back, except in Walk Trot Championship classes.

HALTER CLASSES

1. Class procedure for AHA Recognized shows COMP 815:

A. Judging begins when the first horse enters the ring. From the moment the horse enters the ring its movement is being evaluated. The horse shall enter at a trot, and at the handler’s discretion may either proceed directly along the rail, or trot a counter-clockwise circle at the in-gate end of the arena and then proceed along the rail to the far end of the arena. Upon each horse reaching the designated position at the far end of the arena they are to remain relaxed. The judge(s) will then ask for the next horse to enter the ring. When all horses have entered the ring the horses shall be asked to walk collectively counter-clockwise and/or clockwise past each (and all) judge(s). They shall walk in a relaxed manner on a loose lead with the handler at the side of his horse, whips down. The lead line must maintain a discernible drape and the handler must not place his hand on the chain or close enough to in any way restrict the natural head and neck motion. The handler may not unnecessarily impede the forward motion of the horse while at the walk. Following the cessation of the walk all horses shall relax within the ring and only the horse “on deck” shall be prepared to show. Each horse shall be led to the judge(s) at the walk and presented for judging. In order to satisfy a proper presentation to the judge, horses should stand correctly, bearing weight on all four feet (not stretched), in a quiet and deliberate manner. Following the evaluation by the judge(s), horses shall walk away from the judge(s), and then strike a trot before turning to the left and proceeding counter-clockwise down the rail. They shall resume their position on the rail.

B. Handlers are expected to keep a reasonable clearance between horses and judge of horses to achieve that clearance. Further judging will not commence until the Call Judge approves the placement and spacing of all horses.

C. After the last horse is presented, judges will have a period of time to finish their evaluation of entries and turn in their card (the specific time period to be determined by Show Management).

DEFINITIONS & CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

LIBERTY CLASS SPECIFICATIONS—

HALTERS ON

Horses ARE to be judged on performance, movement, type, presence, and animation. Handler will lead the horse to a designated marker and release horse, keeping halter on. Time and music will start when the horse is released. While at liberty the horse may perform any gait. Any horse performing any tricks or acts under the apparent control/command of the handler will be disqualified. Only 2 handlers are permitted and each may carry an approved halter whip. Horse is not to be stood up at halter before being turned loose. Time expires after 2 minutes and horse will be eliminated if not caught in a further 2 minutes. Each entry will furnish a CD to be turned in at the show office prior to the beginning of the session containing the Liberty class and must be marked with the horse's name, entry number and song number.

PERFORMANCE HALTER

Please refer to USEF Rule Book SUBCHAPTER AR-4 PERFORMANCE HALTER SECTION for general and procedure rules.

Please remember that all horses three years of age and older must have been entered and shown in a performance class at the same show as the one in which the performance halter class is being held, or have completed an AHA or AERC sanctioned Endurance ride or a Competitive Trail Ride recognized by AHA or sanctioned by an AHA recognized Competitive Trail riding organization in the past 90 days.

Horses qualifying via Endurance or Competitive Trail must present dated proof of completion to the show secretary. If classes are held in conjunction with an AHA or AERC sanctioned Endurance ride or a Competitive Trail riding organization, all registered Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian horses entered in the ride are eligible to compete.

ARABIAN COMMUNITY TOURNAMENT

ARABIAN COMMUNITY TOURNAMENT (ACT)

The goal of this program is to offer beginner classes that give new riders a reason to come to an Arabian venue, and to make the opportunity to gain show ring experience as affordable and easy for them as possible. Horses of any breed and riders of any age are welcome.

While here, we hope participants will see the joys of showing and riding Arabian & Half-Arabian horses.

These classes are not meant to replace existing AHA sanctioned classes such as Walk Trot for 10 and Under that qualify riders for Regional and National classes, or 6 and Under Lead Line that is focused solely around the young children.

Walk/Trot Sections are provided to allow multiple riders to show the same horse. ***Sections will be assigned at Coach's request.**

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

RIDERS: Riders are encouraged to be in a professionally operated lesson program and to be a member of AHA, with neither being required. Riding suits and chaps are not allowed. Riding pants, jodhpurs, breeches or colored jeans are considered appropriate. A neatly fitted shirt or top is suggested. **A riding helmet is also mandatory for riders 10 and under and suggested for all ages.** Appropriate footwear with a small heel is mandatory, Riders are NOT allowed to cross enter in to any non-ACT riding classes, and are ineligible to compete in ACT classes once they have shown in a full riding suit or in a Class A Arabian Horse Show.

HORSES: Horses are encouraged to be lesson horses of any breed and should display the characteristics of such, but it is not mandatory that they are utilized in professional lessons. All horses are welcome, as long as they display good manners and a quiet disposition. A cut-back saddle for saddle seat, western saddle for stock seat, and hunt saddle for hunt seat are to be used. Work bridles and bits, including snaffles, are allowed, and running martingales are permitted and encouraged. However, tie down martingales are not allowed. The horse show management may eliminate any horse or rider that is deemed unsafe or

is not abiding by these rules.

ACT entries are to follow horse show rules but are not AHA or USEF sanctioned classes. Show grooming is permitted, but not necessary as HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED.

JUDGING: All academy classes are to be judged on the ability of the rider to control and show their horse to its best advantage and upon the riding skills of the rider. Each class should be judged on the rider's basic equitation and horsemanship skills suited to the class discipline, with emphasis placed on the rider's ability to control the horse at all times, identify correct diagonals and leads promptly, and to control their horses rate in a consistent manner. Riders should convey the impression of good posture, balance, and effective control while commanding proper speed of gaits and show ring placement. Headers are allowed in the lineup in all walk-trot classes. HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED, only the rider's ability to control themselves and their horses and present themselves to their best advantage.

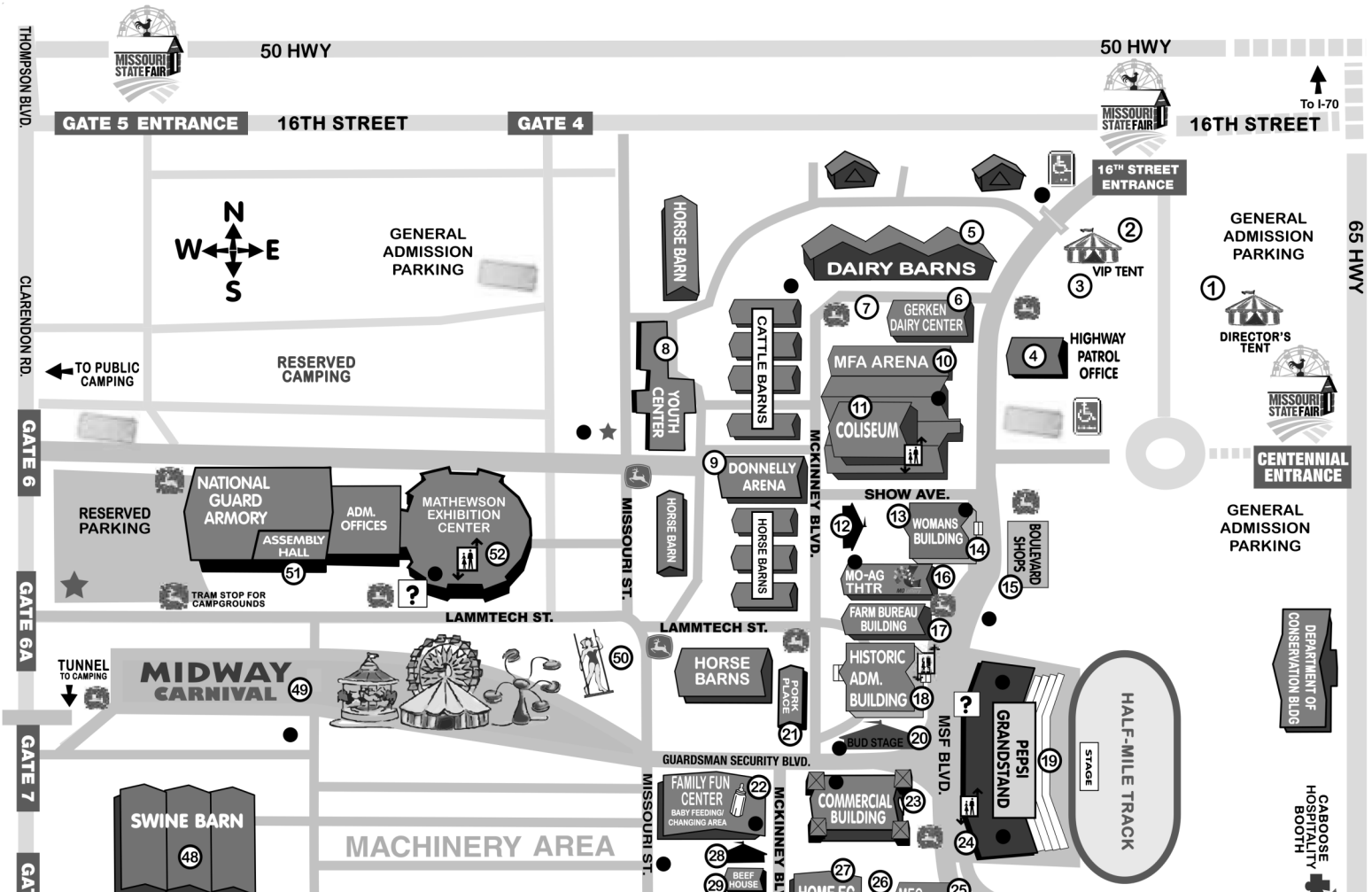
