
Board Meeting

There were some reservations and discussions regarding the expense and responsibility of owning a building with apartments as well office space. There was also discussion about making sure we have apartments available for sober house residents to move into once their year is up.

- VISTA 2 Summer workers early May to Mid August, 35 hours a week. The group discussed the two job descriptions for these positions. April will get Missy a quick narrative write up.
