### From the Director's Desk

The toddler class goes outdoors on every dry day above 35 degrees, the two-year old class at 30 degrees, and the PP, PK and K classes at 25 degrees.

The weather is turning colder and we go outdoors daily. A pair of knit or fleece mittens with a thumb and a hat should be kept at school or brought to school daily. The mittens should be connected together with a string to prevent loss or clipped to the jacket. An easy way to accomplish this is by using a shoelace to connect the mittens. Please place any unattached mittens inside the hat and the hat inside the sleeve of the coat. All items should be labeled with your child's name. **Please send mittens instead of gloves for children under 5 years of age.**
