Winter is here. The children will change into their boots for the playground when it is wet outdoors. Please make sure your child's knit or fleece mittens are attached to their coat using a string or clips. This will avoid parents needing to purchase several sets of mittens. Please bring your child's snow pants, hats and waterproof mittens on any days with snow in the forecast or on the ground. The preprimary children will be going outdoors every day above 25 degrees. The two's above 30 degrees and the toddlers above 35 degrees.

## Hand-Washing
