Goldorok Manifesto

My name is Goldorok.

Since 2014, I've believed in Ethereum. I bought ETH early - not out of speculation, but out of conviction -. I believed in a simple, radical idea: a neutral, decentralized, smart-contract, programmable network capable of becoming the world's economic infrastructure.

From the beginning, I understood that Ethereum wasn't just an open-source blockchain featuring its own cryptocurrency (ETH). It is also a platform for other tokens and for the execution of decentralized smart contracts. While Bitcoin was created as an alternative to traditional currencies - a store of value - Ethereum was designed as a platform for applications.

The analogy: if Bitcoin is a pocket calculator (does one thing very well), Ethereum is like a smartphone (runs many different applications).

And because Ethereum is programmable, developers have built an entire ecosystem of dApps (decentralized applications) on top of it:

- DeFi (Decentralized Finance)
- NFTs (Non-Fungible Tokens)
- DAOs (Decentralized Autonomous Organizations)
- Stablecoins

The ERC-20 standard wasn't a technical detail. It was the birth of a shared language: a base layer on which an entire economy could emerge.

SILENCE AS A DELIBERATE CHOICE

For more than a decade, I stayed quiet. I watched, studied, and held through cycles - bull runs, crashes, doubts, and rebirths -. Ethereum endured.

More than that: Ethereum grew.

Today, cryptocurrency is no longer marginal. Institutions, companies, funds, and now governments are entering the ecosystem. What we've seen so far was only the preparation phase.

THE INFLECTION POINT

Ethereum is now at a historic tipping point. Network upgrades, infrastructure optimization, and evolving standards are converging toward the same outcome: Ethereum becoming not just a settlement layer, but a scalable transaction engine.

The Ethereum network is ready to:

- I. Support mass adoption.
- II. Secure a global economy.
- III. Carry forward the ERC-20 ecosystem.
- IV. Onboard the next wave of builders.

Ethereum is no longer a technological promise. It is an economic backbone.

2026: THE ETH UPDATE

Key challenges to address include:

- Scalability: the network can become congested.
- High gas fees: when the network is busy, transaction fees can become very expensive.

I'm saying this clearly, publicly, and without ambiguity: 2026 will be Ethereum's year.

I've decided to move 750,000 tokens from my historical wallets (273k ETH transferred immediately). This is not a liquidation event. It is a strategic accumulation. I am utilizing these assets as collateral to secure capital and maximize my ETH exposure before this opportunity becomes out of reach for the masses.

This isn't a bet. It's strategic positioning.

THE QUANTUM QUESTION

There is a question serious builders can't ignore: quantum. Not as a headline, but as an engineering horizon.

I've watched "quantum anxiety" hang over cryptography for years. What matters now is not fear, but readiness: cryptographic agility, migration paths, and standards designed to evolve.

As the protocol and its infrastructure harden, I believe Ethereum is moving toward a future where the quantum horizon is manageable - because the system can upgrade without surrendering neutrality.

WHY I'M DOING THIS

This capital deployment has one purpose: to reinforce my ETH position and to support what makes Ethereum inevitable - the builders, the infrastructure, the security work, and the ecosystem that turns upgrades into reality -. Ethereum is permissionless by design - yet it rewards vision.

RECOGNITION AND COMMITMENT

This manifesto is also a tribute:

- to those who believed in Ethereum when no one else did,
- to those who built, held, developed, secured, and defended the ERC-20 ecosystem through every cycle.

Ethereum exists because of you.

CONCLUSION

Ethereum is permissionless by design: anyone can build and participate, while governance and validator consensus mechanisms remain in place. Ethereum moves forward.
