Orlando-Based Nonprofit Launches Nationwide Fire Academy Scholarship Program in Memory of Devon Bellar

Orlando, FL — Devon's Legacy Foundation, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization based in Orlando, is proud to announce the launch of its **Fire Academy Sponsorship Program**, a nationwide initiative that provides full tuition scholarships to young adults pursuing careers in firefighting. The program opens for applications on **June 1, 2025**.

The foundation was created in memory of **Devon Nicholas Bellar**, a passionate, driven 19-year-old who dreamed of becoming a firefighter before his life was tragically cut short in January of this year. Devon was a proud member of the Apopka Fire Explorers program and dedicated his teenage years to serving and preparing for a life of purpose.

"Devon may not have had the chance to wear the uniform, but his heart was already in the fire service," said **Sam Bellar**, Devon's mother and founder of the foundation. "This scholarship program is my way of carrying his dream forward—by removing financial barriers for others who are called to serve their communities."

The **Fire Academy Sponsorship Program** is open to applicants ages 18–26 across the United States who have been accepted into or are currently enrolled in a certified fire academy. Scholarships cover tuition directly and are awarded twice a year—in **June** and **December**.

Through this program, Devon's Legacy Foundation hopes to expand its reach beyond Central Florida, empowering the next generation of first responders with the support and training they need to succeed.
