The hole renovation project and course improvements planned for 2017 are nearing completion.

The board of directors will host a cookout on Saturday, Oct. 22, to thank the **sponsors and donors** who provided funds, services and materials. Invitations will be mailed for the afternoon event. The course will remain open for member and guest play.

Money, money, money

Tim Bryan, treasurer, prepares and posts monthly and year-to-date profit and loss statements on the clubhouse bulletin board.

As the tournament season winds down, it's evident the tournament committee and course improvements combined to deliver increased revenue and expenses.

In addition to dues through August, the club collected about \$8,700 in greens fees, range balls and cart rentals. Tournaments brought in an additional \$5,700. Total income of \$62,628 included renovation donations.

Expenses through August were \$58,226, leaving net income of \$4,401 as we enter the reduced income fall and winter seasons, which continue to apply financial pressure for utilities, payroll, insurance and maintenance.
