



Bryan, Davis elected directors

Tim Bryan and Criss Davis were elected to the board of directors at the April 29 Annual Meeting. They will each serve three-year terms. The season's first end-of-month 18-hole scramble followed.



Topics covered included the need for member involvement in running tournaments, update on greens maintenance, volunteer recognition, and role of markers who volunteer for regional high school tournaments.

Financial steps

Course maintenance and expenses for equipment repair, chemicals, reseeding and greens, along with taxes, payroll, utilities and concessions purchases starts early in the year and quickly surpasses membership installment receipts—especially if payments are delinquent.

While \$1,088 in greens fees through March is more than double a year ago, the early spring weather slowed walk-on traffic. The club could take a short-term loan to help with the \$3,000-\$4,000 shortfall but improved weather, an increase in greens-fee players and several May and June tournaments, it may not be necessary.

What can you do? Pay your dues by the 15th of the month. Play in tournaments. Volunteer at the Snack Bar. Make purchases at the Snack Bar. Invite friends to play the course or consider joining.

What is your board doing? With the recent donation of an iPhone 6, the club can move forward with electronic credit and debit transaction processing for Snack Bar, greens fees, rentals and even dues payments. The Finance Committee is looking into the cost of offering EFT (electronic funds transfer) for members to agree to have their dues autodrafted monthly.
